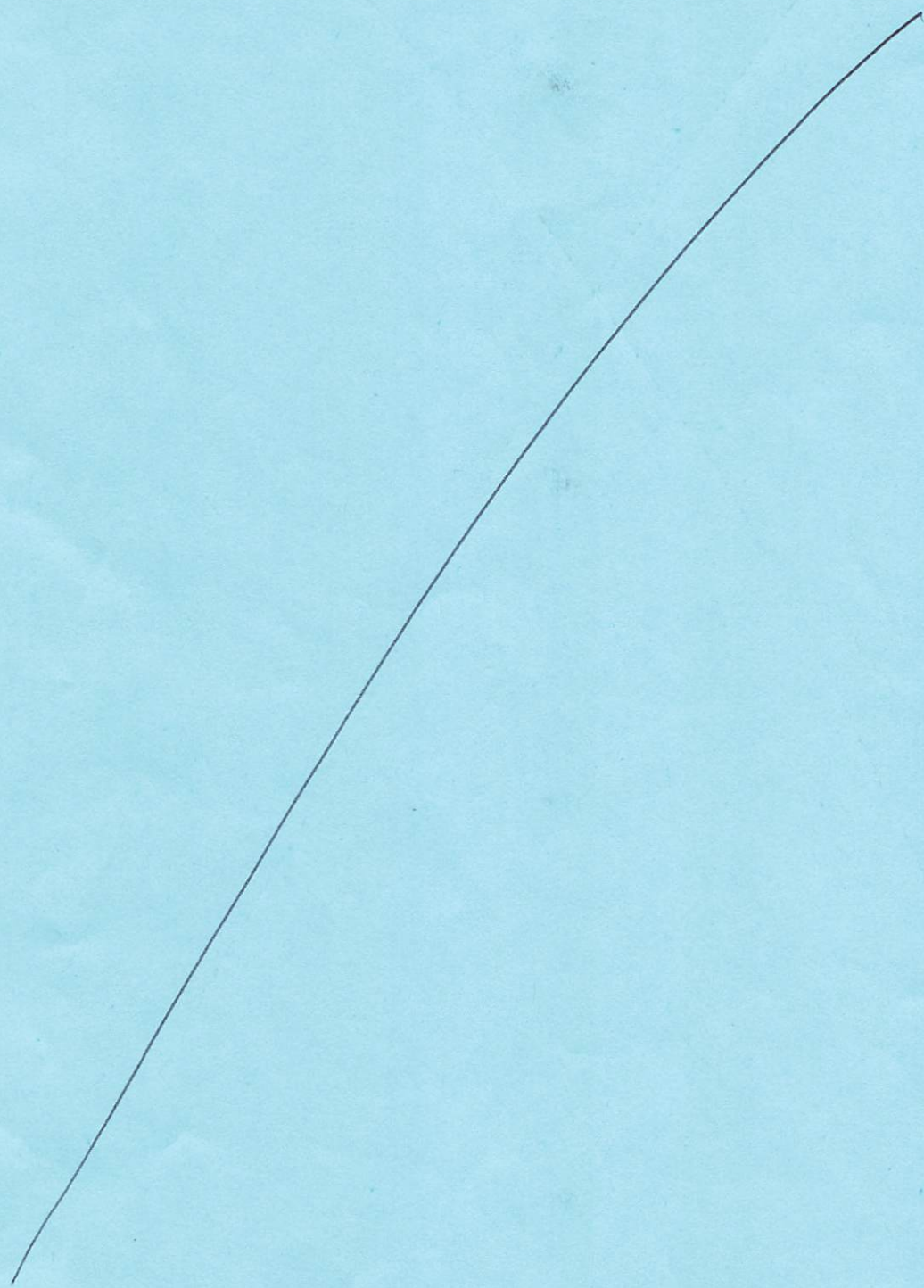

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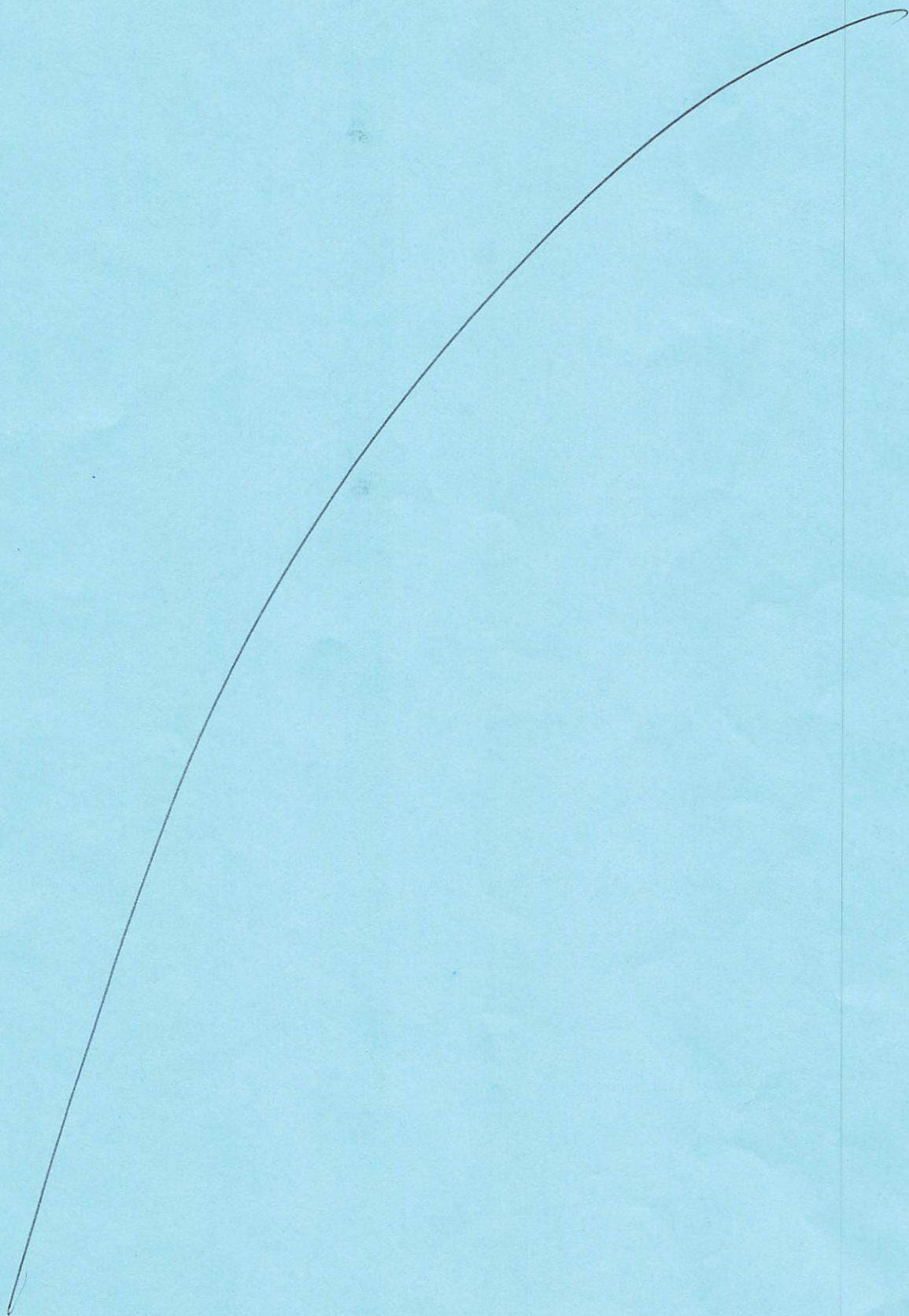

The cemetery was intended to be a community cemetery. It was purchased by 40 families at \$1 each in 1851. Most stayed and paid a yearly maintenance fee.
Immanuel church took over the property in the 1970's due to lack of maintenance. It was sold with the church when they closed. A trust fund is now trying to be raised to maintain the property.

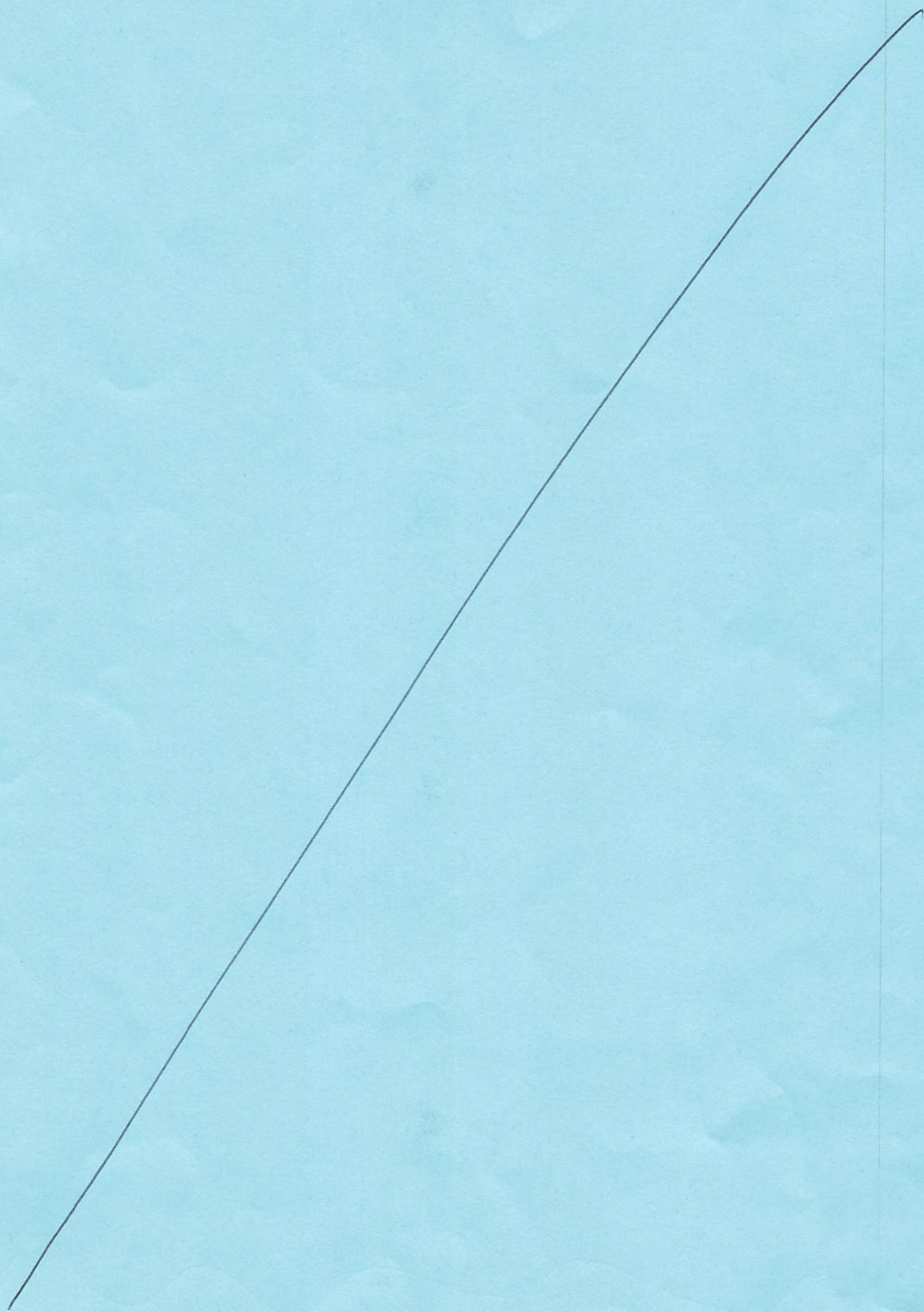

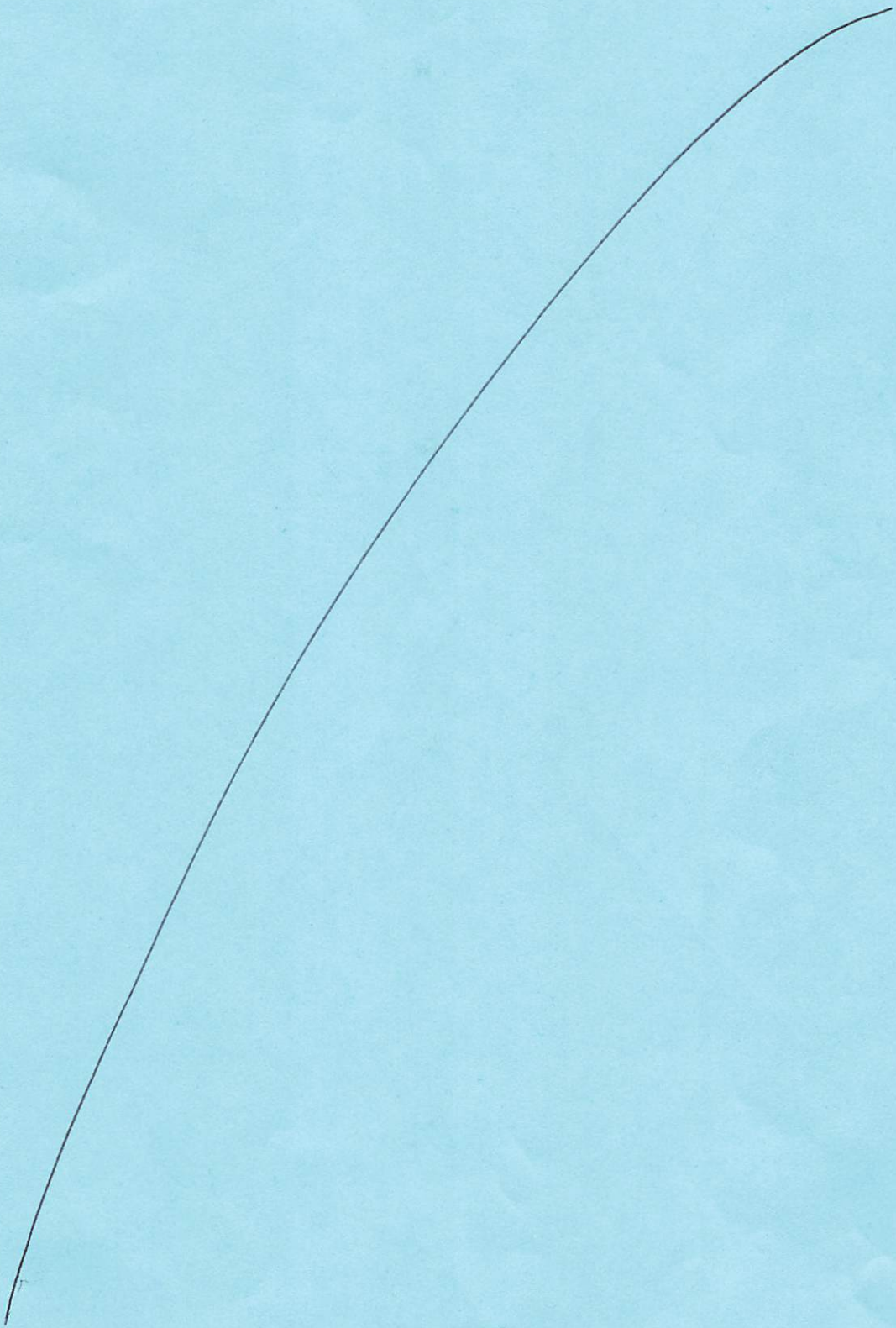

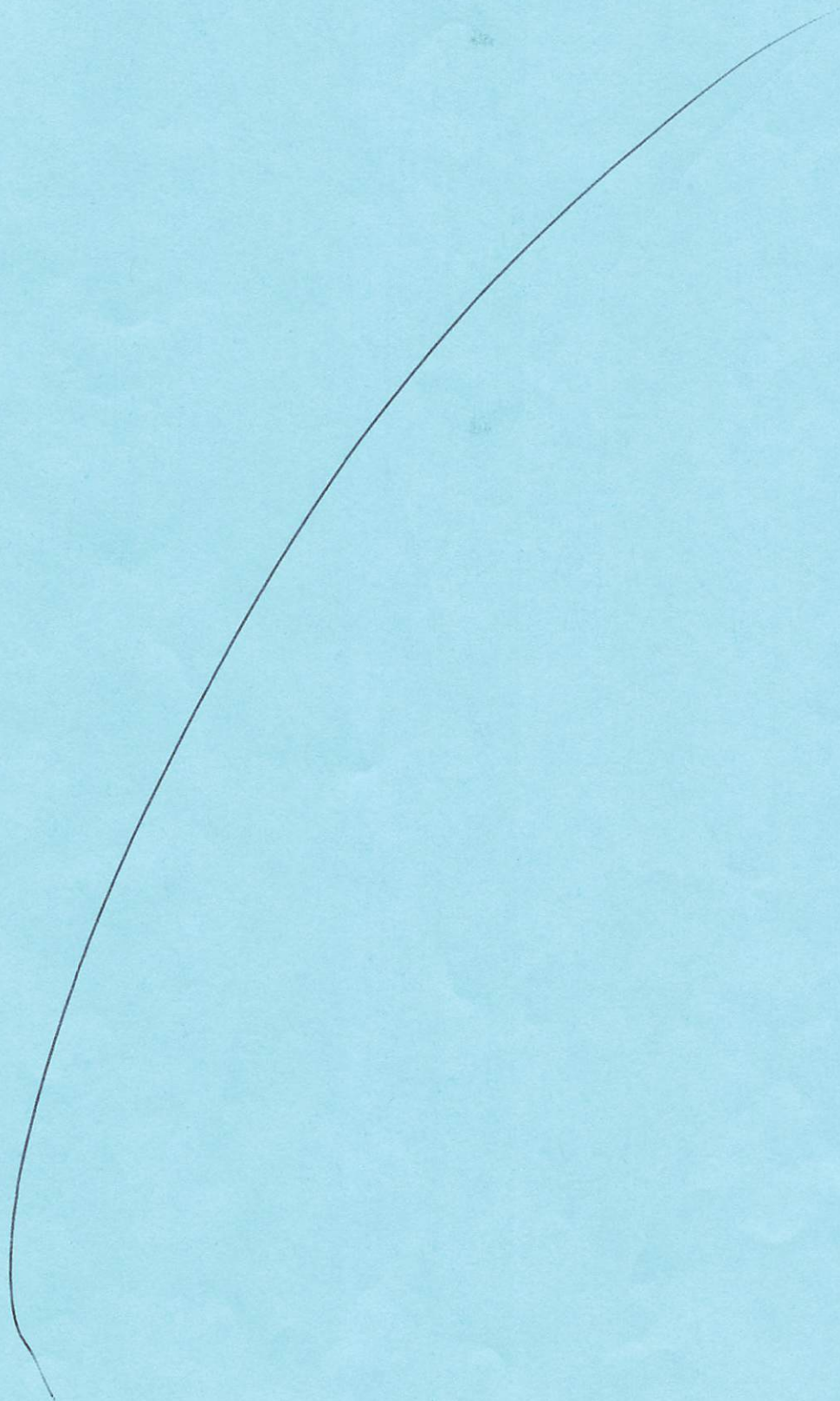
