Comrade John B. WATERS, of Company C, was very sick at this time. His son was a member of the 13th O.V.I., then with SHERIDAN's command. The young man paid his father a visit and finding him in a dangerous condition yielded to his filial affection and remained with him without taking the trouble to obtain leave of absence. The elder WATERS was taken to Fortress Monroe where he died on August 10th.

His wife had been notified of his sickness and came on in time to meet the regiment at Washington, expecting to find her husband sick, but instead found his body being conveyed home by his son and comrades. In addition to the great shock of this, she learned the position her son was in and was indeed greatly worried. She appealed to the colonel and at his suggestion they went with him to see the Secretary of War, and lay the case before him. Fortune favored them, for they found the busy Secretary alone. It was about nine o'clock in the morning and he had just arrived at his office.

The visitors were shown in at once and after listening to a recital of of [sic] the circumstances this brusque and busy man said, "Well, I will fix that," and he at once wrote young WATERS a furlough for sixty days, dating it back so as to cover the time he had been absent without leave. Handing it to him he said, "This will fix matters all right for the time you have lost and give you an opportunity to accompany your mother home and recuperate your health which I see is not good, and when your furlough expires you can rejoin your regiment and do your duty manfully." You may be sure that WATERS and his mother were greatly relieved and thanked Mr. STANTON sincerely for his kindness in extricating the son from his dangerous position.

Young Family Bible Record:

An Example of Information Contained in Civil War Pension Files

Thomas A. Young pension file, "Affermation [sic] of Notary Public," 10 February 1914, Civil War Pension File 1000598, National Archives, Washington, DC.

Editor's Note: Although this is not a record I would normally publish in *Ohio Civil War Genealogy Journal*, I am including it as an example. This document, a partial transcription of the YOUNG family Bible, was included in the pension file of Thomas A. Young of Washington County, Ohio, a private in Company F, 189th O.V.I.

Two of Thomas YOUNG's brothers also served in the Civil War. John R. YOUNG was a sergeant in Company G, 36th O.V.I; Douglas H. YOUNG was a private in Company H, 1st Ohio Light Artillery and a private in Company D, 36th O.V.I.

A search of John R. YOUNG's pension file (file number 1001816) and Douglas H. YOUNG's pension file (file number 196480), revealed that this information is not included in their pension increase requests. John produced a family Bible, but only the births of Susana Jane, John Robert, and Marion Pringle are abstracted. Douglas's pension file did not include any family Bible information.

This demonstrates the importance of obtaining pension files for all family members. Not only does the Bible record from Thomas's file provide marriage information and births of all the children, it also added a child to the family that was previously unknown (William West YOUNG who was born and died in February 1851).


Affermation [sic] of Notary Public:

"... On measurement this bible is found to be 11 ¼ inches long, 9 inches wide and 3 1/8 inches thick, over measurement, and is of the old Family Bible type. The Frond and Rear coverlids are worn apart from the back binding and show evidences of once having been sewed on, but this sewing has worn off and almost entirely disappeared. ... Opening the bible by lifting the front coverlid I find that the front and introductory pages seem to be gone, as the first page here revealed is numbered 17 and marked 'Chapter XV, XVI' at the top...

"On pages set apart for Family records lying and being between the Old and New Testament parts of the above described bible are the following: Marriages. January 8th, 1835 John YOUNG Jr. with Jane Mary DOUGLASS. And on a paged headed "Births" is found the following:

John YOUNG Jr. born July 25th 1798 – Jane Mary DOUGLASS Born September 11th, 1814 – Susana Jane YOUNG Born December 25th, 1835 – John Robert YOUNG Born May 20th, 1837 – Marion Pringle YOUNG Born January 4th, 1839 – Douglas Howey YOUNG Born February 7th, 1841 – Margaret Ann YOUNG Born December 9th, 1842 – Mary Elizabeth YOUNG Born October 4th, 1844 – Thomas Andrew YOUNG Born August 30th, 1847 – Isabel Agnes YOUNG Born June 20th 1849 – William West YOUNG Born February 16 1851 – George Peter YOUNG Born January 2nd 1853 – Grace Adda YOUNG Born March 6th, 1855 – Edwin Archbold YOUNG Born July 22nd 1859.

"On the page of record of Deaths, the entries are very evidently made at various different times with different inks and by different hands. Two of the eight entries here made are in lead pencil. The first record, that of the death of William West YOUNG Feb. 28th 1851, as well as some of the others of that time or thereabouts, were very evidently made by the same hand and with the same pen and ink that recorded at least the greater number of births before given..."

Eulogy of John Andrew Jackson, 20th O.V.I.

John Andrew JACKSON was bon August 1841 in Auglaize (now Shelby) County, Ohio, the son of Joseph and Jane Ann (JELLY) JACKSON. He died 22 July 1900 in San Francisco, CA. The following eulogy was found among the papers of his niece Molly J. HAMILTON, grandmother of Ms. STEUBEN.

Eulogy of John Andrew JACKSON, delivered by the George H. Thomas Post, Grand Army of the Republic -

Friends and Comrades:

Once more the dreaded summons has gone forth and again we have assembled to give to a friend and comrade the last services the living can render the dead. We meet in sadness and in tears, for the greatest grief that can come to the human heart is this last sorrowful parting with these we have known and loved, which this side the grave must be forever.

Often we know it is for the best; often we know it has given our dead friend surcease for racking pain and heart breaking troubles; but while this appeals to our reason it is but little solace to our hearts. Our affections are like the vines that put forth their tendrils and attach themselves to closely to the surrounding objects that when they are rudely wrenched away, we are left wilted and broken. So the loss of our loved ones, no matter when it comes, whether it comes early or whether it comes late, leaves us without interest in the present and almost without hope of the future.

But death is in the world. It is one of the irrevocable decrees of nature and of nature's God that all that is born must die. But if ever death is robbed of all its terrors, if ever we can feel that the fitting moment has come, it is, when full of years and honors, ripe, as it were, for the reaper's sickle, the strong man lays himself serenely down and calmly awaits the final summons. It is not all of life to live not all of death to die. How we live and how we die are the true test of the value of life.

"So live that when they summons comes to join
The innumerable caravan that moves
To the pale realms of shade, where each must take
His chamber in the silent halls of death,
Thou go not like the quarry-slave at night,
Scourged to his dungeon, but sustained and soothed
By an unfaltering truest, approach they grave
Like one who wraps the drapery of his couch
About him, and lies down to pleasant dreams."

Born in 1841 in the celebrated Western Reserve in the State of Ohio, John Andrew JACKSON sprang from a section of country that has produced men of the highest type – men that have become leaders amount their fellows wherever fate has placed them.

When the great civil war broke out, though not yet twenty-one, he threw himself into that mighty struggle with all the ardor of his young manhood.

His record as a soldier is a most enviable one. Thoroughly convinced of the righteousness of the Union cause, and feeling that upon the issue of that terrible ordeal very largely depended the yet unsolved problem of man's capacity for self government in which he most deeply believed, he dedicated his life to the Union cause. He first enlisted in September, 1861, in the company known as the Benton Cadets, from which he was discharged in February, '62, immediately re-enlisting as a veteran in the 20th Ohio Volunteer Infantry.

From the day of his enlistment to the close of the war the story of his life is a part of the history of his country. As a member of the gallant Twentieth Ohio, he took part in many arduous marches and desperate battles of which the memory will live as long as the world loves noble deeds and honors brave men.

He participated in the fierce and bloody battle of Shilohs Church, where twenty men out of every hundred engaged were killed or wounded. His regiment with four other companies for an entire day held in check 15 regiments of Confederates under the Rebel General ARMSTRONG, marching near Boliver to destroy the northward communications of the Union Army, thereby so delaying their movements as to defeat their entire purpose.

With his regiment he took part in the battles of Iuka, Raymond, Mississippi, Champion Hills and Jonesborough.
