RESEARCH AT THE HAMILTON COUNTY COURT HOUSE

PROBATE OFFICE (Room 537) has Wills, Settlements (Administration) of Estates, Application Records, and Guardianship Records.

The index books for these are on the tables in the room, or on shelves to the far left side of the room (as you enter). These volumes first are divided according to periods of years (listed on the title), and then, on the pages, by alphabetical arrangement of the last names by their first letters. You may also find the surnames subdivided and grouped according to the first letter of the first name. --For example, if you are looking for "Samuel Jones", you look for the index on "J" surnames and then the subdivision in the J's for the first names beginning with "S".

The Will Books, with handwritten copies of the original documents, are stored on shelves immediately to your right, as you enter the room. On rare occasions, if you decide you want a xerox copy of the Will, take the reference information (the probate date and estate number) to the ladies in the office beyond the half-door at the back of the room. --They can pull out the original Will, which is in the vault, and can make a xerox copy of it for you (two pages for 25 cents).

The records on the Administration of Estates are usually searched when the person died without a Will; --you may want to look at these, anyway. The entries in the Administration Books, which are housed in the little side room to the left, do not give you much information except perhaps to name the widow as administratrix. However, in some cases, you will also see here a reference to the Application Book (volume and page number). It is this latter source that lists all the heirs of a person (and usually their addresses). The Application Books are also housed in that little side room, but the earlier volumes have been removed to the Court House basement. You are welcome to go down there also, in pursuit of your information; I understand that someone is stationed in the basement to help you.

The Guardianship Records are on the shelves to the left, in the big room, with index book also on the nearby table.

PROBATE OFFICE (Room 549) is down the little hallway, next to Room 537. Here are stored the records of Marriages, Births and Deaths (--not many), and Naturalization (or citizenship). The shelves to your left, as you enter the door, have the index books and/or the record books for all except the Marriage Records.

You must request, from the ladies in the inner office, the index books to the Marriage Records, according to the year or period of years you are interested in searching. Once you copy the reference (volume and page) from the index book, you may find the records by yourself, as those books are on shelves next to the writing tables in the main room.

Notice that the first Marriage Record volumes are labelled as Series "A" and Series "B", with some having the same numbers (such as "A-21" and "B-21"). --I have been more successful in finding the information in the "B" series, when only the number of the volume was given in the index.

A certified copy of a Marriage Record may be obtained, for \$2.00. Inquire of the ladies in the inner office, as to the procedure.

The indexes to Naturalization Records may or may not lead you to the records (which are on microfilm--the few that remain). Some of the documents were lost during the Court House fire in 1884. Take your reference to someone in the office and they will search the microfilm for you. If you find the correct record, it will tell you only the country from which the person came, the date of his oath of allegiance to the U.S., and the citizen here who vouched for his character. A xerox copy may be obtained from the microfilm; I believe the charge is 50 cents.

COMMON PLEAS COURT (Room 329) has additional records on Naturalization (from 1851 on), as well as on other Court proceedings. (--You may someday want to check on a lawsuit between the relatives!)

The five volumes having to do with citizenship are labelled with the word "Aliens" on them. These are on a low shelf immediately to the right of the long center aisle in the room, and about half-way along that aisle. --Ask someone, if you can't find them. These volumes include (1) an index to court proceedings and (2) declarations of intentions to become citizens, the latter giving the name of the applicant and his age, his original country, the port and date of departure from Europe, and the port and date of entry into the U.S.

You may have xerox copies of any of the pages, simply by taking the book over to the desk and requesting a copy (20 cents per page).

The RECORDER'S OFFICE is located on the second floor of the Court House, along the whole east hallway. It has Deeds, Mortgages, Leases, and some records on the establishment of businesses, etc. From a genealogical standpoint, the early Deeds are helpful in giving the wife's name in connection with her "dower rights" (--a sentence found down near the bottom of the document), when her husband sold his property. A Deed may also name the heirs of a person in connection with the settlement of his estate, after his death. --Often a farm acreage was divided up and given to the children, or it was sold by them to another person. (Be sure to look for the date of the transaction, usually written into the text of the Deed at the beginning or at the end of it. Also make a notation of when it was recorded at the Court House. --Sometimes, the two dates were several months or years apart!)

Procedure for finding a Deed:

1. About a third of the way down this long room (Recorder's Office), after you pass the front desk and a couple of rows of book shelves, you will come to a section, on your right, where large tables have been pushed together to make an even bigger "table", and you will see several large flat gray books lying on it. These are index books to Series Volumes. A sign hanging from the ceiling over the main aisle, near this area, tells you the periods of years covered by each Series.

"On nearby walls, in several places, you will see old maps of Hamilton County (1847, 1869, and later). Look at these to make sure you know the location of the property you are interested in, by the Range, the Township, and its Section number, or by the municipal incorporation (village or city) which it is in.

Decide the period of years you want to search, and take up that index book for that particular Series. (The books are labelled: Series 1, Series 2, Series 3, etc.) Inside, the book is alphabetically arranged so that you may look for the township, or the village or subdivision, and its reference to the corresponding Series Volume (number and page) where the Deeds for that location will be listed.

If you are searching for a property in an unincorporated area, rather than using the gray index books, look at the quick-reference chart tacked on the aisle-end of the bookshelves, under the ceiling sign, previously mentioned. --It is important to know the Range number as well as the numbers of the Township and the Section you want to search (from the maps and chart), since the Series Volume pages are labelled at the top, according to those numbers. This chart, like the gray index books, directs you to the Series Volumes and pages you will need to look at to find the lists of Deeds."

2. The Series Volumes are presently being put on microfilm, so you will find Series 1, Series 2, etc. on films in the next section of the Recorder's Office. The remaining volumes are still on the shelves next to the big table where the index books are.

The Series Books (or volumes) are basically another index. This time they give you the list of property transactions (within the specified period of years). The transactions (Deeds and Mortgages) are for each recorded lot in a village or city of Hamilton County, or for a subdivision thereof; or, they are for the particular Section of a Township (Sections 1-36. At least one page is devoted to each Section). If you know the name of the person you are seeking, in that location, you will find him as the "Grantor" (seller) or the "Grantee" (buyer) of a property, --with the reference to the actual Deed (Deed Book Volume and Page) accompanying this listing.

If you do not know the location of your ancestor's property, but you think he may have owned some in Hamilton County (--Don't forget: he may have just rented it!) --You may look in the

Indexes of Deeds according to names, which are also on microfilm and labelled according to periods of years. These names are alphabetically arranged only by the first letter of the surname.

3. The microfilms and the microfilm readers (---machines that look something like TV screens) are just beyond the table where the index books were. You will see many microfilm readers there, ---maybe about 30 of them, and stools to sit on. The machines along the main aisle, only, will produce xerox copies for you, but it is recommended that you view the microfilms on one of the other machines first, so that you don't monopolize the use of the copiers. If you don't know how to use a microfilm machine, ask the person sitting at the aisle desk, or just about anyone else that looks friendly!

The microfilms themselves are on a "wall" of shelves, next beyond the big table (where you were before); these are the "Deed Books", with the Volume letters or numbers labelled on them. Also, on a smaller set of shelves, nearby, you will find the Series Books or volumes (on microfilm) and the Index of Deeds by Names, mentioned above.

A. Select the microfilm you want, (B) put it on a microfilm machine, (C) find the page on the film, and (D) read the document you wanted to see. (The writing may be enlarged by adjusting the knob marked, "Zoom", and it may be clarified by turning the knob marked, "Focus".) If you decide you want a copy of the Deed, transfer your film to one of the machines on the main aisle, put a dime in the slot and wait a second; ---the copy will come out near the top of the screen. (You might be wise to take a supply of dimes along to the Court House, in anticipation of using these machines.) If the copy is too dark or too light, there is a dial to adjust, ---but you may prefer to ask the person at the desk for help so that you don't risk losing a lot of dimes in trying to get a readable copy!

Whatever happens, don't be discouraged. Always feel free to ask anyone for assistance. The people at the Court House are usually outgoing and helpful. Good Luck!

ANCESTOR - "Research Reference" CARD FILE:

Help us to help you! Use the following rules and send a card for every ancestor about whom you have at least the name, one date and one place of residence that can identify ancestor.

1. Use 3" X 5" cards.
2. Only one generation to a card, husband and wife should be on same card if the information is known.
3. Children, or other information, may be added on the back of card if so desired, but this is not required.
4. Type, or block print the entire card, capitalizing the surname.
5. No card to be submitted unless it contains one name, one place and one date.
6. Make cross index card for wife, using maiden name.
7. No limit to number of cards which may be submitted. No restriction to place of residence.
8. Name and address of person submitting card must be included in lower right hand corner of card or on back of card, along with date submitted.



EARLY ROAD SURVEY: 2nd in series as submitted by Ruth Wells.


August 3, 1805 Samuel W. Martin, surveyor, with John Gaston assisting laid out a road leading from the north boundary line of Hamilton County to the Colerain Road (now Belmont Avenue in College Hill), to a point 92 poles south of the ten mile tree; reviewed by John Ramsey, junior, Israel Brown and Samuel W. Martin. Starting at the north boundary line of the county on a line running south between the lands of Zadok Stephenson and Samuel Leming on the East and Paul Huston on the west... (This road followed the line of present day Pippin Road to a point a short way south of Houston where it veered southeastwardly to the present line of Hamilton Pike just above New Burlington and then on the general line of the Pike as it goes south through Mt. Healthy and College Hill.) Pippin Road today dead ends at the county line. This road must have been laid along the early trace leading to Fort Hamilton. An 1836 map of Butler County shows the continuation of the road. At the end of Muskoff Road in Butler County traces of it can be seen coming down the hill. It cannot be found on Butler County maps after 1836, but in May 1810 a survey of sections one and two was made by Thomas Henderson, surveyor of Hamilton County. This was done to make the roads, now Pippin and Kemper, the boundaries for the farms owned at this time by Samuel Leming, Paul Huston, William Hunter, and Ogden Ross. This map also shows the road continuing into Butler County.

IMMIGRANTS FROM THE OLDENBURG MÜNSTERLAND TO AMERICA

Part I: Vestrup, Haustette and Lüsche

The following is a list of immigrants from Oldenburg to America. The source of this information is a book entitled Pastor Heinrich zu Höne und seine Familienforschung, Quakenbrück, Germany: Robert Kleinert GmbH, 1968. Father zu Höne (1875-1943) compiled genealogies of families, making note when individuals "wanderte nach Amerika aus." The book is divided into five sections: **Part I Vestrup, Haustette and Lüsche Families; Part II Damme Families; Part III Dinklage Families; Part IV Carum Families; and Part V Other Families.**

In some instances, specific references to Cincinnati are found. In many cases, possible connections to Cincinnati can be found if one checks these names in the Index of Death Notices and Marriage Notices Appearing in Cincinnati Volksfreund 1850-1908 by Jeff Herbert. The list is not alphabetical in order to show some family relationships.





We hope to see you at this meeting of the German Interest Group on Tuesday, September 27th.




