CENTRE TOWNSHIP

The first settlements were made in this township between years 1805 and 1812. Among first settlers were: JOHN BAKER, JOHN WINLAND, LEVIN OKEY, PETER PALMER, ELIAS and JOSEPH JEFFRIES, JESSE and ABRAHAM JACKSON, WM. GRIFFITH and MARTIN BAKER.

Among first burials in this cemetery were Sarah Okey, dau. of Levin, who died about 1812; Levin died in 1829 and his mother Elizabeth Okey died in 1824, aged 103 years.

On account of the burning of the court house in 1867 there are no records of early marriages in probate office. Among the first marriages were: Joseph GADD & Miss HENTHORN Daniel O'CONNOR & Rebecca CARROTHERS and Elijah PATTERSON & Sarah MINOR. The first child born in the township was Sarah JEFFRIES dau. of Elias & Deborah (JACKSON) Jeffries.

Some others here before 1826 were: Mrs Clarinda FORD, wife of Thomas Ford, Mrs Eliza CRAIG, widow of Wm. Craig and dau. of Ezra DRIGGS and also Mrs Louisa GUTHRIE widow of James Guthrie and dau. of Robert NAYLOR.

Among the first tradesmen in Woodsfield were: Mr. UMPHREY, blacksmith, Joseph DRIGGS and John COLL, cabinet makers; Abner POWELL stone mason; John KING, Wm. MASON and James SHAW, hatters; John HESKETT and Henry MASON, wheelwrights; Daniel O'CONNOR, tailors, James CUNNINGHAM, saddler; Patrick ADAMS, brickmaker; Messer SAYRES and Reuben THOMAS, shoemakers; Elam PATTERSON, Anson BREWSTER, David PIERSON and John SMYTH, storekeepers.

Among first members of the M.E. Church with their wives about 1825 were: Levin Okey, James Cree, Arthur Okey, Thomas Morris, John Clingan, Jesse Jackson, William Moffitt, Susan Kean and others.

RIEDINGER, PETER, JR was b in Randolph Township Aug. 1, 1850, son of George P. & Susan Riedinger. He md Emma Weaver, dau. of George & Charlotte Weaver of Stark County. His brother Frederick b Nov.16, 1840, md Louisa Ackerman of Stark County, dau. of Matthias & Henrietta Ackerman.

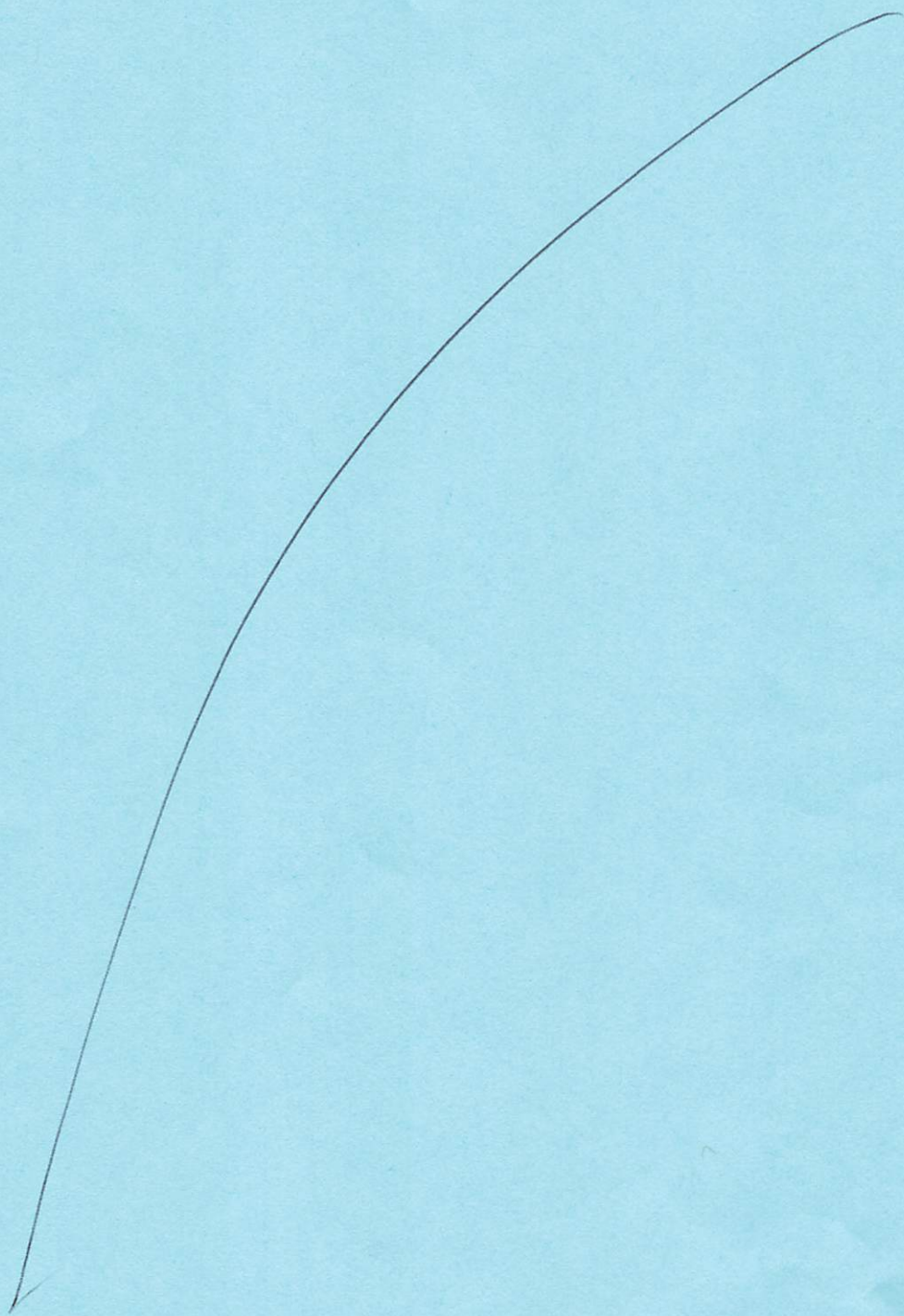

The Chapel Hill Cemetery can be found by starting at the intersection of Ohio Route 78 and Monroe County Route 145 in Lewisville; continue west 3.5 miles on Ohio Route 78 to a dirt road, Monroe County Route 33, on the right just beyond the St. Joseph Catholic Church. The church is also on the right or north side of Route 78. Take Monroe County Route 33 for 0.7 miles to the first dirt road on the left. Take road 63 for one mile to the cemetery.

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the mother of ten children, four of whom are living. She was ranked amongst the best of mothers, always endeavoring to put forth all her power to influence the young to shun all appearances of evil. In the course of a long life she had won the esteem of all who were personally acquainted with her. For many years she had been afflicted with an unknown disease, the pains of which she bore with all calmness and fortitude, until death released her. Her body was placed in the Grassy Knoll Cemetery to which place her husband preceded her some eighteen years ago. M.J.W.¹²

James and Catharine's son, Daniel O'Connor Jones, was born 20 Sep 1827 in Laings, Monroe County. In 1850, he was living with the Isaac Atkinson family in Adams Township. Isaac was the grandson of Daniel's uncle John Jones. On October 20th of that year, Daniel married Sarah Ann Wilkinson.

Sarah was born 13 Dec 1832 in Belmont County, Ohio, to Joel Wilkinson and Jane Reed. Sarah's grandparents were early settlers in Belmont County. Her paternal grandparents, John and Ama (Small) Wilkinson arrived around 1805 from New Jersey. Her maternal grandparents, Amos Reed and Jemima Kennard also came to Ohio before 1810. Amos was a Revolutionary War veteran, serving in the New Jersey line under Captain Thomas Yard. He enlisted in 1776 or 1777 at Trenton and was discharged at Easton, Pennsylvania, at the close of the war.

Following their marriage, Daniel and Sarah remained in the Laings area. About 1870, they moved to Jackson Township, Monroe County.

They were the parents of eleven children. James Harvey (Lucy Stine), Joel (Martha Thomas), Catharine (1. William Rush, 2. Earnest Hartlieb), Mary (Philip Potts), Samuel Grimshaw Jones (Mary Belle Rush), Amanda Jane (George Potts), Caroline (Isaac Eddy), Ruth Ellen (Jerd Shook), Margaret (Walter Priest), Sarah Marinda (died at the age of 5), and a still born daughter.

Sarah died at the age of 45, perhaps from complications of the birth of her last child, which died at birth. She was laid to rest at West Union Cemetery in Perry Township. Daniel died 10 years later.

OBITUARY: 1888 - Died of consumption on the 15th inst., at his house in Jackson Township, Daniel Jones, aged 60 years, 4 months, and 25 days. The deceased was born in Green Township, Monroe County, Ohio. He was a good citizen and was respected by all who knew him. He was ever kind as a father, and leaves a large family to mourn his departure from them. He also leaves an aged mother, one brother and three sisters. At an early age, he united with the Church of Christ and was buried with Christ in baptism, to arise and walk in the newness of life.

Samuel Grimshaw Jones was born 1 Feb 1860 in a home near Laings. He was named for the doctor who delivered him, Dr. Samuel Grimshaw. Samuel married Mary Belle Rush on 20 Mar 1890. She was the daughter of Slater Benson Rush and Prudence Morris. Samuel and Mary had the following children:

Charles Manford (Leota Farmer), Lewis Webster (Bertha Wright) Evaline (Charles Yost), Nola Belle, Amelia Jane (George Schoonover), Fred William (Eva May "Kate" Hayes), Linza Joel (Nona Jones), Nona Rhea (Clennon Snell).

Samuel and Mary raised their family on a farm in Jackson Township. Their son Fred and his wife Kate purchased the adjoining farm. For the past 212 years, there have been nine generations of the Jones family who called Monroe County home.

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Miltonsburg Free Burial Ground

Wilbur "Webb" Haslam identified this cemetery as the Miltonsburg Free Burial Grounds. He copied it circa 2000. It is located about 3 miles from Miltonsburg. According to the WPA survey done in the 1930s, there were two veterans buried here. One was Civil War veteran Benjamin Reed (row 3 grave 7) and the other was unknown (row 15, grave 8).

These wills were abstracted by Catharine Fedorchak and published in Volume 11 of her "Early Records" series. You will note that some of these wills were reentered after the 1867 fire of the Probate Office. The following abbreviations were used:

Wf: wife, dau: daughter, ex: executor, wit: witness, twp. township.

Wife or children "not named" means they were mentioned in the will but no names were given. The first date is the date the will was written and the second date is the date of probate.

p. 223 John FUCHS of Green Twp. Wf Anna, son Christian, John, dau Ann, Margaret and her son Frederick. David BERLT, husband of dau Anna, "shall have no claim on my property or estate after my decease." 21 Aug 1852/22 May 1862

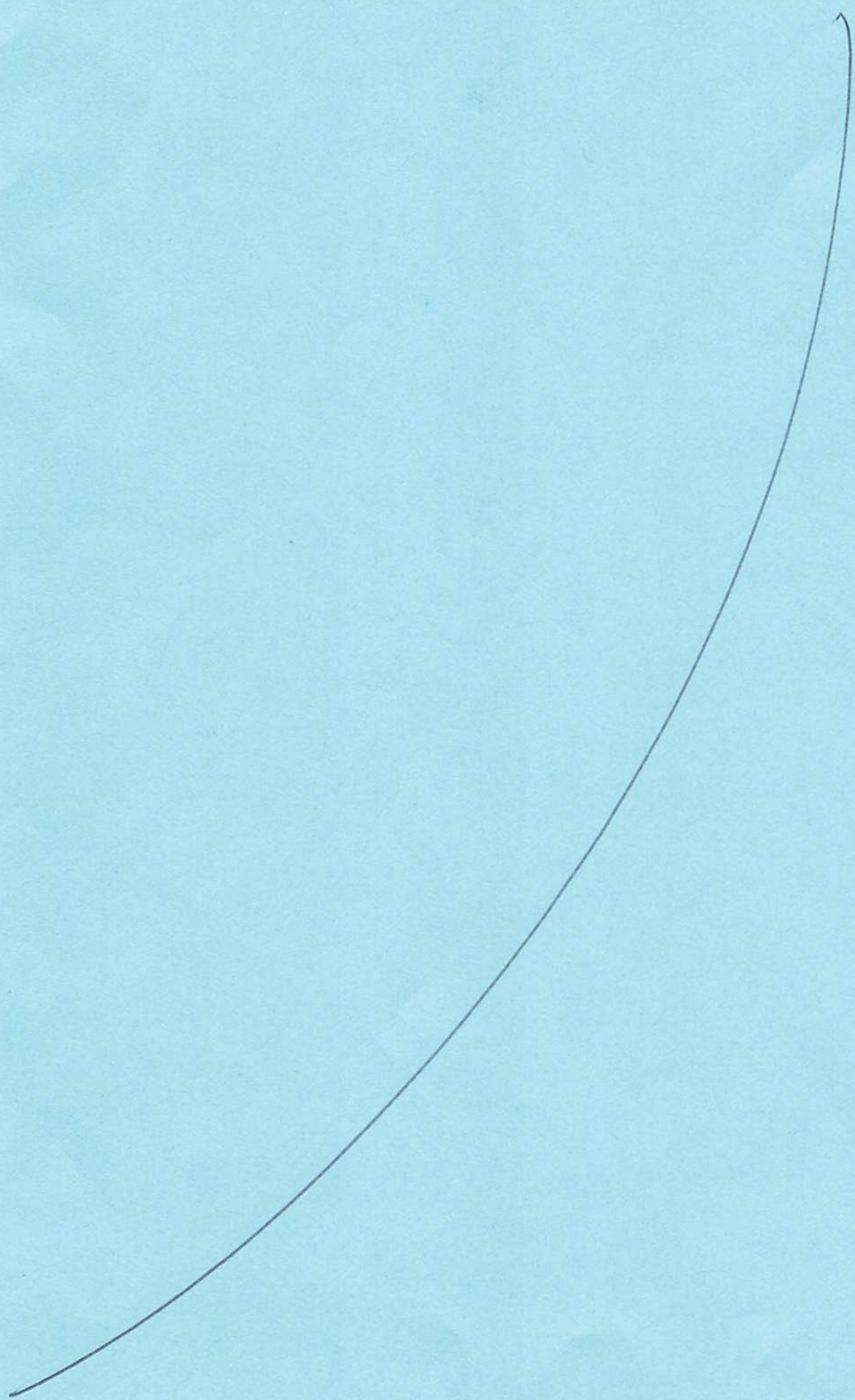

Hines Chapel Church of Christ Cemetery

The Hines Chapel Church of Christ is found on County Road 16 (Sandbar Road) in Franklin Township. The church was established around 1884. In 1908, George Hines purchased the Methodist church building, which had been built on the property of Joseph Hines, and moved it to this location. At that time it became the Hines Chapel Church of Christ.¹

Copied by Jean Craig, Bud Craig, and Karen Romick in August 2007. Catharine Fedorchak and Ruby Heft made an earlier reading in 1966. Eva Jean Hartshorn also completed an earlier copy. Many of these stones have weathered and were difficult to read.
