SERVED IN BOTH ARMIES

Robert Coe Dies at the County Infirmary—Well Known Here.

The death of Robert Coe occurred at 11:50 o'clock last night at the county infirmary. He was a well known character and his failings were a penchant for large quantities of intoxicants and for taking horses which did not belong to him and for the latter offense he served two years in the penitentiary. The most creditable part of his life was his service in defense of his country and this amounted to a term of over eight years. He was born in Virginia seventy-four years ago and entered the army of this country at the opening of the Mexican war and served throughout that conflict. He then enlisted in the Regular army and was in this service when the war of the Rebellion broke out and he served for some time in the defense of the flag but at the expiration of his service in the Regular army went to Virginia and entered the Confederate service. He deserted after a short time and came back to Ohio. He was admitted to the county infirmary about 1870 but has been discharged and readmitted several times.

SOME CEMETERIES BURY IN CHRONOLOGICAL ORDER

When searching cemeteries, you should be aware that religion sometimes had a lot to do with the way people were buried. Here's a good example: In the old country, Lutherans were buried "in order" of death. There was a row for children (with small stones), and one for adults. When winter came, the church would dig six or seven graves and cover them with straw in anticipation of coming deaths that winter. That way, the church members didn't have to dig through frozen ground or go to several different spots in a cemetery. When people died, they were buried in chronological order. So, if you're visiting one of these cemeteries and you can't read a stone that sits between two others that are legible, at least you'll know the person's approximate date of death.

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GABRIEL'S CEMETERY

M 2.3 X

On Tuesday, March 1, 1994, in front-page, bold headlines, the Times Recorder ran a story entitled: "Tombstone Discovery at Ritchey Facility Site." It goes on to say that plans for the Ritchey Produce Company's new facility at the Muskingum County Airport industrial park may have hit an unexpected snag by the discovery of a tombstone which was found lying face down and was covered with an accumulation of debris.

Although the land had been checked by an engineering firm to do environmental, historical and archaeological surveys they missed the fact that a family cemetery was located at the edge of a wooded area. The tombstone was discovered by Commissioner LARRY MERRY, and when it had been lifted from the debris it was found to hold the inscription of DELILAH GABRIEL, died July 25, 1865, at 58 years.

Evidently extensive research had not been done concerning the history of this land which is now managed by the Port Authority. Had the book of Perry Township Cemetery Inscriptions which was published by the Muskingum County Genealogical Society, and which may be found in the genealogy room of the McIntire library, been checked they would have found that mention of GABRIEL'S CEMETERY is made in that book. Mention of the GABRIEL'S is also to be found in Everhart's and Goodspeed's histories of Muskingum County. Early records of the GABRIEL family and the land they homesteaded may also be found at the Court House.

The stone discovered by MR. MERRY is that belonging to a great great aunt of MRS. IONE B. SUPPLEE of Zanesville, a genealogist and historian, who has supplied the following information:

"ABRAHAM GABRIEL came from Antrim Township, Franklin Co., Pa. to Ohio in 1807, and on 12 November 1807, he purchased 497 1/2 acres of land lying and being in the third quarter of the first township in range 6 of the United States Military District of Ohio, which land lies in Perry Township, Muskingum county. The land was purchased from JONAS STANBERRY of New York City, N.Y. for the sum of One Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Dollars and Six Cents. This became known as GABRIEL'S PLANTATION.

MR. GABRIEL, a widower, came to Perry Township accompanied by his sons, RICHARD and JONATHAN, and their families. In 1808 he died and was buried on his plantation. His was the first death in Perry Township, and his place of burial became known as GABRIEL'S CEMETERY, it being the oldest cemetery in the township.

RICHARD and JONATHAN GABRIEL continued on the Plantation with their families until after their deaths, after which time their shares were sold by their heirs. RICHARD died 18 March 1847, and his wife SUSANNAH, died 6 July 1846, and they are buried in the Salt Creek Baptist Cemetery near Chandlersville, Ohio. JONATHAN GABRIEL died 8 August 1850, and his wife, MARY, died in 1853. They were the parents of 4 daughters: ELIZABETH, who married GEORGE GREEN; MATILDA, who married SOLOMON THOMAS; MARIA, who married ALEXANDER WILSON, and DELILAH, who never married, who is the one whose stone was recently uncovered by Commissioner LARRY MERRY. JONATHAN and MARY GABRIEL were also the parents of a son, ARCHIBALD, who married ELIZABETH.

Commissioner LARRY MERRY, JONATHAN and MARY GABRIEL were also the parents of a son, ARCHIBALD, who married ELIZABETH SCHUMACHER, a neighbor girl. ARCHIBALD and ELIZABETH are the great great grandparents of IONE B. SUPPLEE. ARCHIBALD died in 1832 leaving 3 children: LORENZO, MARY ANN and LUCINDA, great grandmother of MRS. SUPPLEE. MR. and MRS. JONATHAN GABRIEL, their son ARCHIBALD, and daughter DELILAH are all buried at GABRIEL'S CEMETERY, as is DELILAH'S infant daughter.

After the death of her parents, DELILAH lived at Sonora, Ohio. Her will was written 12 July 1865, in which she left money to erect headstones for her daughter, her parents and herself. MRS. SUPPLEE has a copy of DELILAH'S will in her possession, as well as a copy of ABRAHAM'S land purchase, the estate settlement, quit claims and the wills of JONATHAN and RICHARD. The following is an excerpt from the will of DELILAH GABRIEL which was filed at the Muskingum County Probate Court on 4 August 1865:

'Item First: After the payment of all my just debts, funeral expenses, etc. I want my Executors to erect around my family graveyard, which will contain my father, mother, daughter and self ---- a stone wall mounted with iron railing, also a family monument to represent the above named persons.'

ADAM TURNER and JACOB LHANE were named as Executors of her will."

Now after one hundred and eighty-six years the peaceful resting place for ABRAHAM GABRIEL and his family seems to be lying in the path of modern progress, and the fate of the cemetery hangs in the balance as authorities try to work out a proper solution to the problem.

Sometime we all must pay a price ----- even the dead.

ABRAHAM, JONATHAN and ARCHIBALD GABRIEL, have all been documented into First Families of Muskingum County by MRS. SUPPLEE and those records may be found in the genealogy room at McIntire Public Library.

On the 23 March 1994, I was invited by Commissioner Merry to visit the GABRIEL family cemetery. The only grave marker remaining within the cemetery is the stone DELILAH made provisions for in her will. The following information was copied from the grave marker.

THIS MONUMENT ERECTED BY

THIS IS ALSO TO REPRESENT
HER DAUGHTER WHO
LIES ON THE NORTH
AND HER FATHER & MOTHER
ON THE SOUTH
