



HIPP, GEORGE b in Europe Mar. 10, 1818, son of John G. & Anna. George md 1st in 1839 Christina Ausfahl b in Europe who d in 1874 and had son John G. George md 2nd JACOBINA LOESCH, a widow with 2 children, Cettie who md Benj. Fox and Philip Loesch.

RIEDINGER, PETER, JR was b in Randolph Township Aug. 1, 1850, son of George P. & Susan Riedinger. He md Emma Weaver, dau. of George & Charlotte Weaver of Stark County. His brother Frederick b Nov.16, 1840, md Louisa Ackerman of Stark County, dau. of Matthias & Henrietta Ackerman.

MOOS, ADAM and wife Elizabeth were natives of Baden, Geroamny and came to this county in 1842. They had a dau. Elizabeth b April 1846 who md Joseph Coler and had 4 children.

KLING, GEORGE b in Baden, Germany Mar. 22, 1825, son of Nicholas & Katharine Kling. George md in St. Louis Margaret Loubert, dau. of Martin & Anna M. Loubert who came to this county in 1848. They had 7 children.

SCHMIEDEL, JACOB b July 28, 1845, son of Jacob & Mary C., natives of Baden, Germany, who came to Randolph Co. in 1843. Mary c. d in 1878. Jacob Jr. md Catherine HAAG b in Stark County in 1851, dau. of Jacob & Barbara Haag.
