Grace United Church of Christ Uniontown, Ohio

In Ohio and Pennsylvania during the early settlement of Lutheran and Reformed people, they worshipped together in what were known as Union Churches. In a given community, they shared a common house of worship. In Uniontown, from 1818 until the late 1800's the Lutheran and Reformed congregations worshipped together in part of the building now occupied by St John's Evangelical Lutheran Church.

Eventually some differences caused the Reformed congregation to split and on 10 Mar 1843, several members of the Reformed constituency formed the Union Town New German Reformed Church. John R Bowers and John Weimar became Deacons and Lemon Bowlin and John Buck were elected Elders.

At the organizational meeting, a subscription plan was approved to finance a building and on 20 May 1847 the new building was dedicated. The site was just south of what is now known as the Union Mission Church on Church Street, the building occupied by Grace Church before it moved to Cleveland Avenue.

There are some gaps in the continuity of the church's history -- some of its records have been lost or destroyed. But fortunately, many of its public records are intact.

When the New German Reformed Church in Uniontown was organized, neither English nor German synods had been instituted. Local churches were structurally related to the General Synod of the Reformed Church in the United States.

Progress was slow, tedious and difficult for the new congregation. Its humble size required it to share ministerial leadership for more than a hundred years with neighboring Reformed churches. Transportation was an obstacle. Roads were unimproved. Pastors were limited to foot travel or horse and buggy. Also the German language requirement limited leadership. In less than a year the Reverend Jesse Hines was dismissed because he could not speak German. Pastor George Schlosser resigned at the end of three years because the distance between parishes was too far.

Years of the Civil War and immediately afterward were years of hardship. Indefinite numbers of pastors enlisted while others increased the number of parishes served. Pastor Abraham Miller served 3 churches in 1865, 4 in 1866 and 6 in 1868. The parishes were small -- Uniontown was yoked with Suffield and New Berlin at this time -- but the travel was demanding. In 1863 the Uniontown parish was comprised of 50 women and 28 men.

About this time the English language was the predominant tongue and in 1864 the name was changed to Second Reformed Church. The Reformed pioneers who remained with the Lutheran Reformed organization were known as First Reformed Church. In 1878 the name became Emanuel Reformed Church and ten years later (1888) it was again the Second Reformed Church.

The spirit of togetherness was moving the Reformed Churches in Uniontown and in 1888 First Reformed Church withdrew from the Union Church and consolidated with Second Church and the name chosen for the union characterized its theology -- Grace Reformed Church; and Grace it has remained through the denominational name has been altered on two occasions by way of mergers -- first with the Evangelical Synod of North America (1934) and then with the Congregational -- Christian Churches (1957).

In 1958 11 acres of land was purchased at 13275 Cleveland Ave for a new building. In 1962 an Educational Unit was finished and in 1978 a sanctuary was added.

<u>List of Members</u>

There are a number of membership lists in the oldest record book spread out over the years 1846 to 1875. Some are a complete list of members and others are for a confirmation class. All lists were typed with the date shown for each person. After being alphabetized, duplicate names were deleted, leaving each different name with the earliest date. These are contained on the following pages.

The minute book contains much information on the running of the church and the listings of the officers. Apparently complete records of baptisms were not kept. Only 4 marriages were found and only those deaths listed above were recorded although a few funerals were shown. Many spellings were found for the names. In most cases the original spelling is retained.
