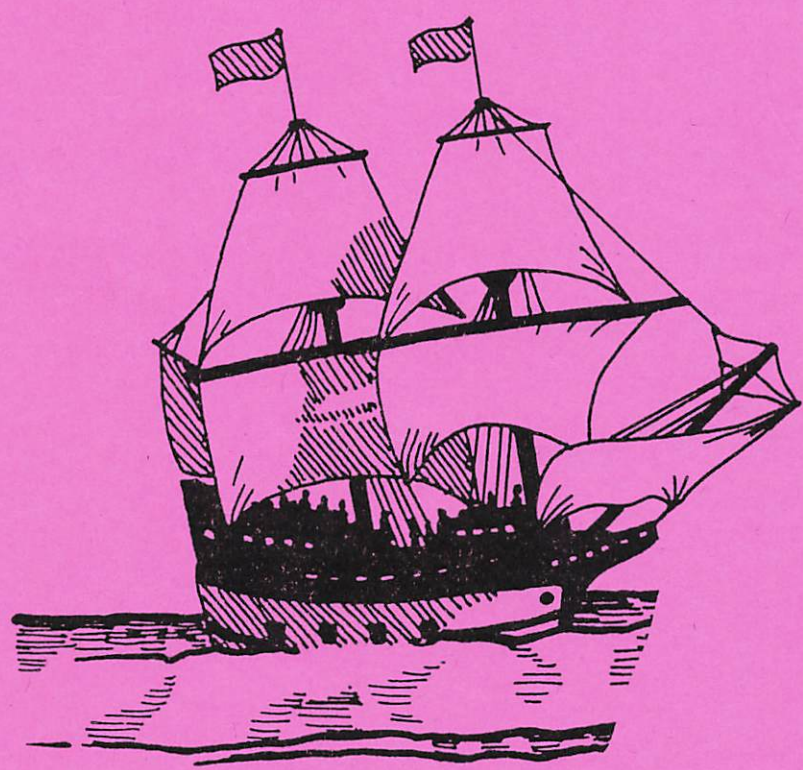

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## FORWARD

These Naturalization records are the earliest found in Summit County Ohio. The information is often sketchy, with no back up volume to refer to. The explanation to that is not pleasant to read, but true nevertheless. Many many record books were taken from the Summit County Court House over the years and destroyed. Our genealogical society is doing it's best to see that this past destruction is remedied.

Thanks to Clerk of Courts Diana Zaleski, we were able to assist the microfilmer from the archives at the Genealogical Society of the (Mormon) Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, to microfilm Summit County Naturalizations from 1840 to 1935. Those records are available at the Summit County Court House, Clerk of Courts Division, as well through any Family History Library in the world.

The records contained in Volume A, were published first in several monthly issues of THE HIGHPOINT, our chapter newsletter.

This printing is a corrected version, printed alphabetically, and will be easier to use.

Many of you will notice that no female names appear. That is because from 1790 to 1922 the wife became naturalized upon citizenship conferred to her husband; no separate filings were required. An act of September 22, 1922 made it mandatory for a woman to be naturalized on her own .

You may also note that pages 126, 142,201 appear to be missing. They were not in the book to copy, and since no application numbers are missing, we believe they were simply not numbered. Altogether the original Volume A spanned pages 1 to 225.

Wherever there are blank columns, there was no information given. It is entirely possible the applicant was naturalized in another county or state.

Our Summit County Chapter hopes you will get needed information from this publication. We hope to follow with Volume B by the end of 1994.

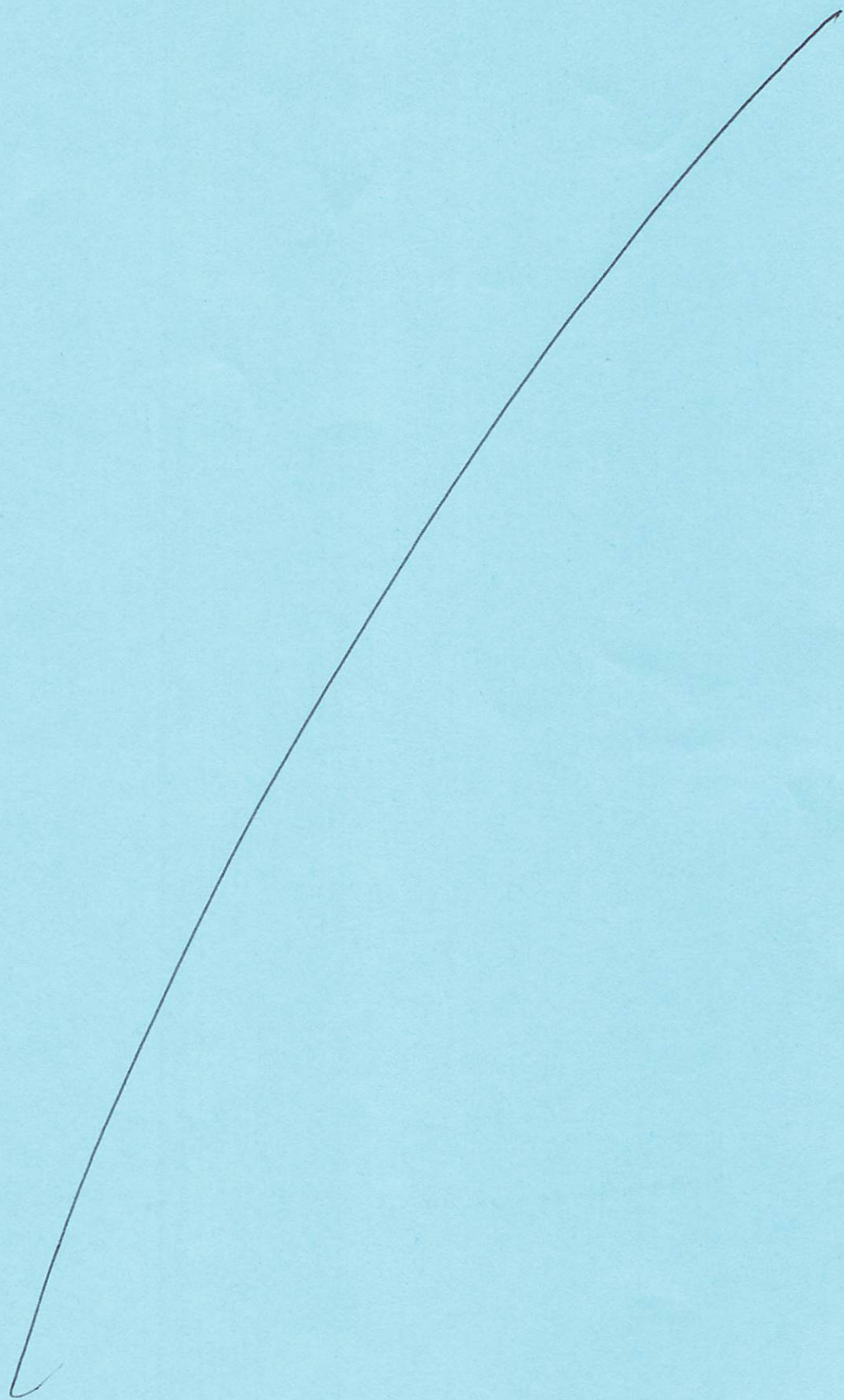

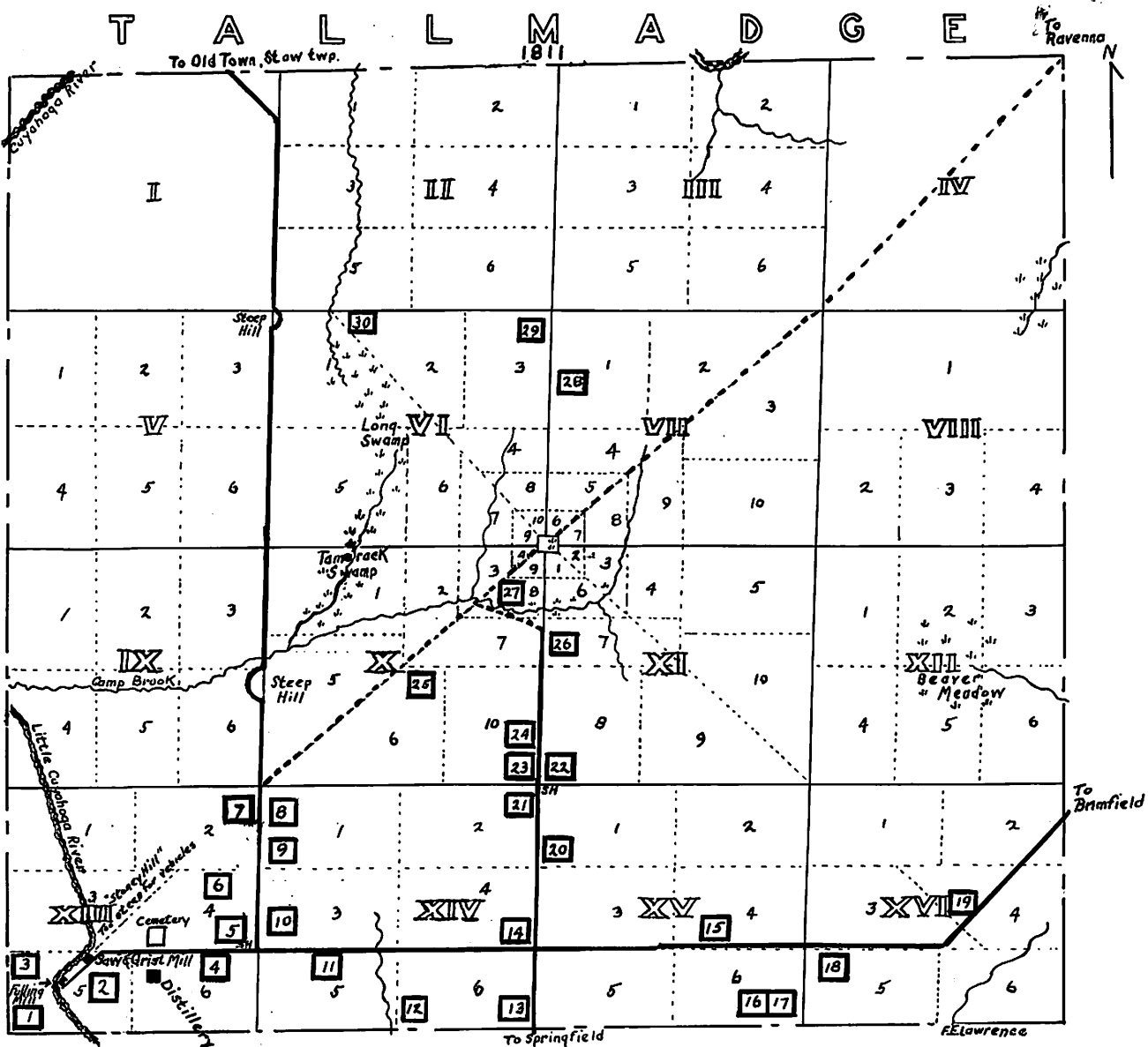

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








### KEY TO MAP OF TALLMADGE 1811

TALLMADGE, OHIO - 1811

Tallmadge has been in the Northwest Territory, Trumbull County, Portage County, and since 1840 in Summit County.

What was Tallmadge like 160 years ago? Who lived in Tallmadge then?

Thanks to Charles Cook Bronson Tallmadge has wonderful old records. From those records, supplemented from others, the above questions can be delightfully answered. This in spite of the fact we have no Ohio census records to help us at the time Tallmadge was first settled. The Ohio census records of 1810 were destroyed in 1814 when the British put the torch to our government buildings in Washington, D. C.

Charles C. Bronson was 14 when, in 1819, he came with his parents and brothers and sisters to make Tallmadge his life-long home. Though a farmer, Mr. Bronson developed into a Tallmadge historian. Much of his writings were from personal observation. He did not stop there, however. He interviewed original settlers, recording their statements. Sometimes he traveled considerable distances to view and record from Bible records, family histories and conduct interviews. He carried on lengthy correspondence with others. From Mr. Bronson's writings we can reconstruct the following:

Tallmadge was laid out by the Rev. David Bacon for an agricultural Puritan community. At that time Tallmadge was on the western frontier of the United States, surrounded by sometimes unfriendly Indians and thirty days (and longer) travel from New England, much of the way through unbroken forest.

The Rev. Bacon is said to have contracted with the owners for 12,000 of the 15,000 acres in Tallmadge, to be paid for in three equal annual installments. This would seem to have been an optimistic arrangement on the part of all parties. But any chance for his plan to succeed was thwarted, for the ink was scarcely dry on the contracts when, because of the lawless acts of both Great Britain and France, and embargo was imposed to prevent trade with Europe. That was tragic, for Europe was the outlet for our produce and manufacturers. Factories, having no place to sell their products, were forced to shut down; this threw great numbers out of work. Many who were interested in Mr. Bacon's plan couldn't dispose of their New England properties, so were unable to finance a relocation. In 1811, on foot, Mr. Bacon had gone to Connecticut. His was a dual mission: to endeavor to obtain extensions on his contracts (he was unsuccessful), and to find more high quality people for his Puritan community. Actually Tallmadge is greatly indebted to the Rev. Bacon for the high calibre people persuaded to settle here and who, from the first, established a high moral character for the community.

From Connecticut the Rev. Bacon wrote his Tallmadge friends asking for a letter describing the township. He desired this letter for use as a sales aid. The people, proud of their Tallmadge settlement, were only too glad to comply. This was the letter they sent:

"At the request of the Rev. David Bacon, we give the following statistical account of the town of Tallmadge (which is No. 2 of the tenth range) for the benefit of those who are desirous of removing to that place, in doing which we have been careful to exhibit an accurate presentation and such as will be found to agree with actual examination.

"The settlement of Tallmadge was begun July 1807 by the Rev. David Bacon for the express purpose of collecting a religious congregation and upon the plan to unite them in sentiment and the support of a minister.....The settlement has been made mostly by persons from different parts of the Reserve, allured by the goodness of the soil & the hope of enjoying Christian privileges until the summer of 1810 when four families removed to the place directly from Connecticut. (Note: Those four families were: arrived Jan. 31, 1810 Thomas S. Williams; arrived June 26, 1810 David Preston, Sr. and family and Drake Fellows and family; arrived June 30, 1810, Elizur Wright, family and two hired men: Justus Barnes and Shubael Lowrey. Both of those hired men soon bought land in Tallmadge from Elizur Wright (Wright had bought nearly 4000 acres) and married. F.E.L.) There are now 29 families in the Town containing 164 persons of which 69 are children under 10 years of age, 31 between 10 & 21 years of age and 64 heads of families and young men and women over 21 years.

"The town is about thirty miles distance from Lake Erie and about seven miles from the Portage of the Tuscarawas branch of the Muskingum; a river that empties into the Ohio at Marietta. This river is passable with boats of four or five tons burden from the Portage and about forty-five miles further down with larger craft. It is also about seven miles from the Portage of the Cuyahoga, a river that empties into Lake Erie; this is also boatable but it is not considered as good as the Muskingum. The face of the land is in some parts hilly but the greater part of the town is moderately ascending & descending. The hills are nearly all capable of being cultivated.

"There are no ponds and no stagnant water of an extent worthy of notice in the place. The two most considerable marshes are the Beaver Meadow in the east part of the town containing about one hundred acres and the Long Swamp in the West part containing about fifty acres. These are covered in part with bushes only and in part are open intermixed with grass and herbage yielding a considerable food for cattle; they have streams running from them and by cultivation may be rendered excellent hemp and meadow land. There are several patches in various parts of the town of less extent, and of a similar description. All the land that we know of which may be considered waste land is a Tamarack swamp of about thirty acres and a cranberry marsh of about three acres unless we should reckon a few inconsiderable patches of stones. The valleys are many of them of considerable extent, rich, and suitable for meadow.

 "A remarkable degree of health has prevailed here since the settlement. The soil for the most part is a medium between a sandy loam & a clayey loam, a moderate proportion is a sandy loam and very suitable for corn *corn* and in some parts of the town the soil may be termed a clayey loam. So far as we can judge from the growth appearance and kind of trees the herbage and the crops where trial has been made the land is fertile. The character that has uniformly been given of it by all that we have heard make any observation about it is, that it is a good township of land. With some variation in point of fertility the land is generally good and is well proportioned for plow land meadow and pasturing. There are few if any lots but what would make tolerable farms, and many we think excellent. It is our opinion that the unsettled parts of the town are of as good a quality as the settled. The surveyor who laid out this town has this remark in his field book 'that the herbage in the township is much greater than is general in the country and there is a great portion of the township in which a man may be followed by his trail.' The timber on the upland is Oak, several varieties, Chestnut, Hickory, Boxwood, Ironwood, Poplar, Sassafras, Butternut, Black Walnut, Gumwood and Cherry tree, and on the low land moist ground Beech, common and sugar Maple, Cucumber tree, White & Red Ash, Whitewood, Butternut, Black Walnut, Hickory & Elm. The greatest proportion of the timber is Oak, Chestnut and Hickory, but in many places especially in the Eastern part of the town Beech & sugar Maple is interspersed with Oak Chestnut White Ash Whitewood etc. In the valleys are to be found Crab apple and Plum trees and Nine bark bush and many places abound in Spice Bush of a large growth which is considered an indication of good grass land. A branch of the Cuyahoga passes through the North West corner of the town, and a smaller one through the South West part; they each afford a number of as excellent mill seats as can be found on the Reserve. At no great distance from these iron ore in various places has been discovered but a trial has not yet been made of its quality. Besides these are a number of brooks which run through different parts of the town and the land especially the hilly parts abounds in springs that do not fail in a dry time, the waters of which are generally good soft & fit for washing. We consider the town to be exceedingly well watered. There is in most places a sufficiency of stones for building and in some for fencing. The stones are easily wrought into shape, and are of a sort that make good grind stones. In the South West part of the town there is a Grist mill, a saw mill and Fulling mill. The Grist mill is capable of going at all seasons and affords grinding for the adjacent towns in a dearth, when all other mills fail. A machine for carding wool is contemplated to be set up next summer. *Mills* *Water* *Mills*

Besides the excellent description of the physical features of the township, this letter gives a recap of the population of Tallmadge, by age groups, as of March 30th, 1811. Based on Mr. Bronson's records, and with supplemental data from other sources, we are able to turn this recap into a census - a really detailed census - with considerable accuracy.

As stated in the letter, in the extreme southwest corner of the township the waters of the Little Cuyahoga river had been harnessed. That locality was first known as Tallmadge Mills, then Middlebury. Middlebury is now part of the city of Akron. We begin our enumeration in that business district and fan out from there in a northerly direction to cover the locations of the residents at that time.

It is quite possible that Tallmadge is the only town in the State of Ohio that can boast of such a detailed census in that particular decade.

### THE BETZ FAMILY

The following is excerpted from "BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH OF THE BETZ FAMILY" by G. M. Gault, Germano, Ohio. W. E. Roberts, Publisher, 1892-93. The little book is the property of Mrs. Chester Sycks, Akron, Ohio, who is the gr-gr-gr-granddaughter of Anna Betz Crider.

In 1757, Ludwig BETZ came to Philadelphia from Alsace, France.

New York World clipping 1889: Peter BETZ, drummer for 5 years in Rev. War. Married at age 67, second wife 25 years old (b. 1803). Peter born 1761. The widow of Peter appears on the Pension Roll from Dauphin Co. Pa.

William BETZ lived at Kingston, Ross Co, Oh. and a Solomon BETZ lived at Circleville, Oh. Solomon was at one time Sheriff of an eastern Penna. County.

In the summer of 1833, the house of George BETZ was destroyed by fire and with it the old Family Bible. From a paper obtained from George MOORE --- Abraham BETZ, b. Philadelphia, Aug. 14, 1743. --- Eve Bowers, b. Reading, Pa., Oct. 1, 1761. Each were married the second time. She was the second wife.

Abraham BETZ bought a tract of land of 400 acres from Peter SEIDEL on 22 Feb. 1794 which had been entered 1 Mch 1793 by Joseph VANGUDY and 400 acres from George SELLERS. Witnesses: John BETZ, then over 21, and John METZGAR, husband of Margaret HARVEY.

Abraham BETZ provided by will for three children by his first marriage and ten by the second. In the fall of 1790 Abraham BETZ bought a farm 4 miles above Steubenville. He was a blacksmith. He died 3 Jan. 1821. His will gave Mary Croninger 175 pounds Penna. currency; John, the farm upon which he was then living; Elizabeth HEIFER 600 acres of land; to each son by his second wife, a Quarter Section of land in Twp. 10 Range 3 in the Steubenville Land District; to each daughter 80 acres of land in the same township. The widow died 16 June 1831.
