## Cemetery Inscriptions

**P**HARISBURG, Ohio, cemetery records furnished by Allen D. Sheneman of Santa Ana, California. He states, "On a recent trip to the village of Pharisburg, Leesburg township, Union County, Ohio, I asked some of the older people where I might find the old Bannon graveyard. I was told that hardly anyone around there knew anything about it as it had not been kept up or cared for over the past hundred years. I did find the place, as recorded in the Union County History. It was a half mile east of Pharisburg, back along the creek, across a large field. It was well protected by many strands of barbed wire, rather close together, making it almost impossible for anyone to get inside. I did get in finally by finding a low place where I could stretch the barbed wire up a little and crawled under. It looked as though there hadn't been anybody alive in there for many years. Among all the underbrush, weeds

as high as my head, and tall grass, I found the grave markers. Most of them had fallen over. It was impossible to read all the data on them, however, I did copy much of it best I could. The first burials here appear to have been made in 1839, the last about 1855."

Henry H. GANDY, died (half of the marker missing. Other records show he died March 27, 1849).

In memory of Sally, wife of Henry H. GANDY, departed this life Sept. 1, 1846, in the 62 year of her age. Her glass is run, she sleeps in clay, waiting until resurrection day.

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Mr. Sheneman notes that,  
 "This is the end of the Brannon  
 graveyard records. Some cannot  
 be read. I also visited the old  
 Smith graveyard, just off road 128,  
 which runs along the south border  
 of Leesburg Township. I found it  
 at the end of a long lane which had  
 once been a road, according to the  
 1877 map on which its location is  
 shown. It is uncared-for and the  
 markers are hard to find and very  
 difficult to read. It was used from

1845 to 1887, apparently. The  
 following is all I could copy."



CONVERSE-GARTON Cemetery is  
located on land which was  
previously owned by James  
Converse and before him is was  
owned by David Garton. In 1985  
it was owned by Welsey Mercer  
and records don't indicate a  
change in ownership of the land.





## THE OLD OAKDALE CEMETERY -INFORMATION FROM THE FRONT OF THE OAKDALE CEMETERY BOOKS.

Oakdale was the second cemetery at Marysville, the first being located on North Walnut Street where the Farm Bureau buildings are and the rail road tracks are located on some of the land. It's not known when this cemetery was first used. It was mentioned in some council meeting records in 1846 and 1848. This information is from the Marysville Centennial booklet of 1969.

Removal from the Old Cemetery was started in 1893 and at various times after that more were moved until 1903 when the last of them were moved. Many bodies, as bones, were placed in one box because it was not known who they were as the stones were unreadable, or there were no stones at all.
