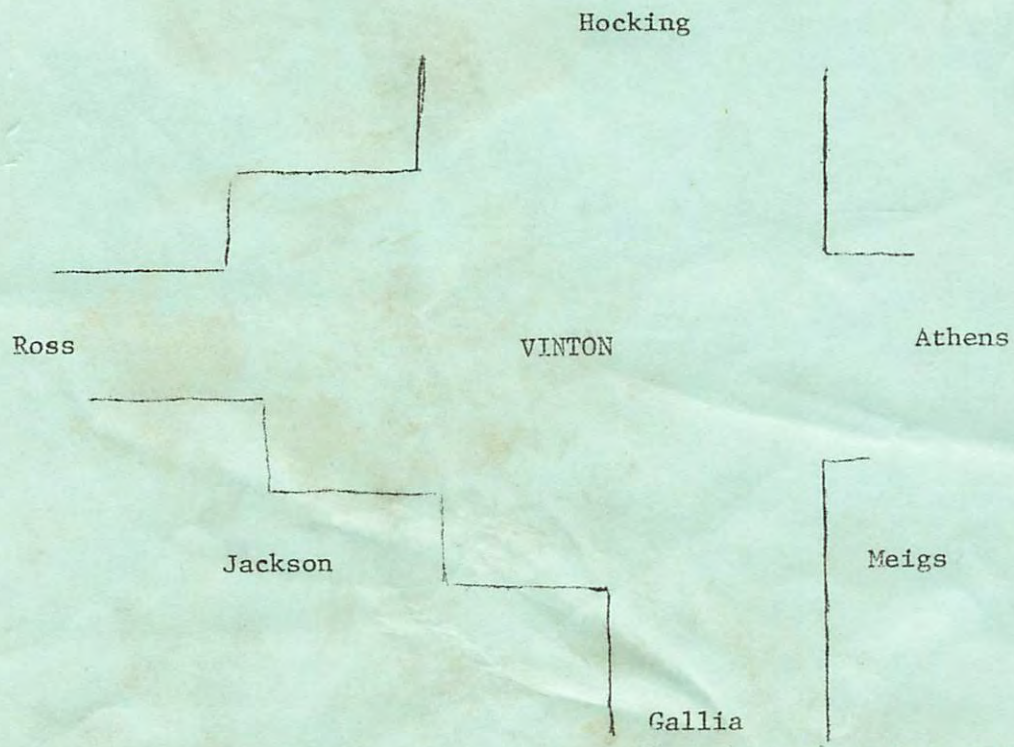

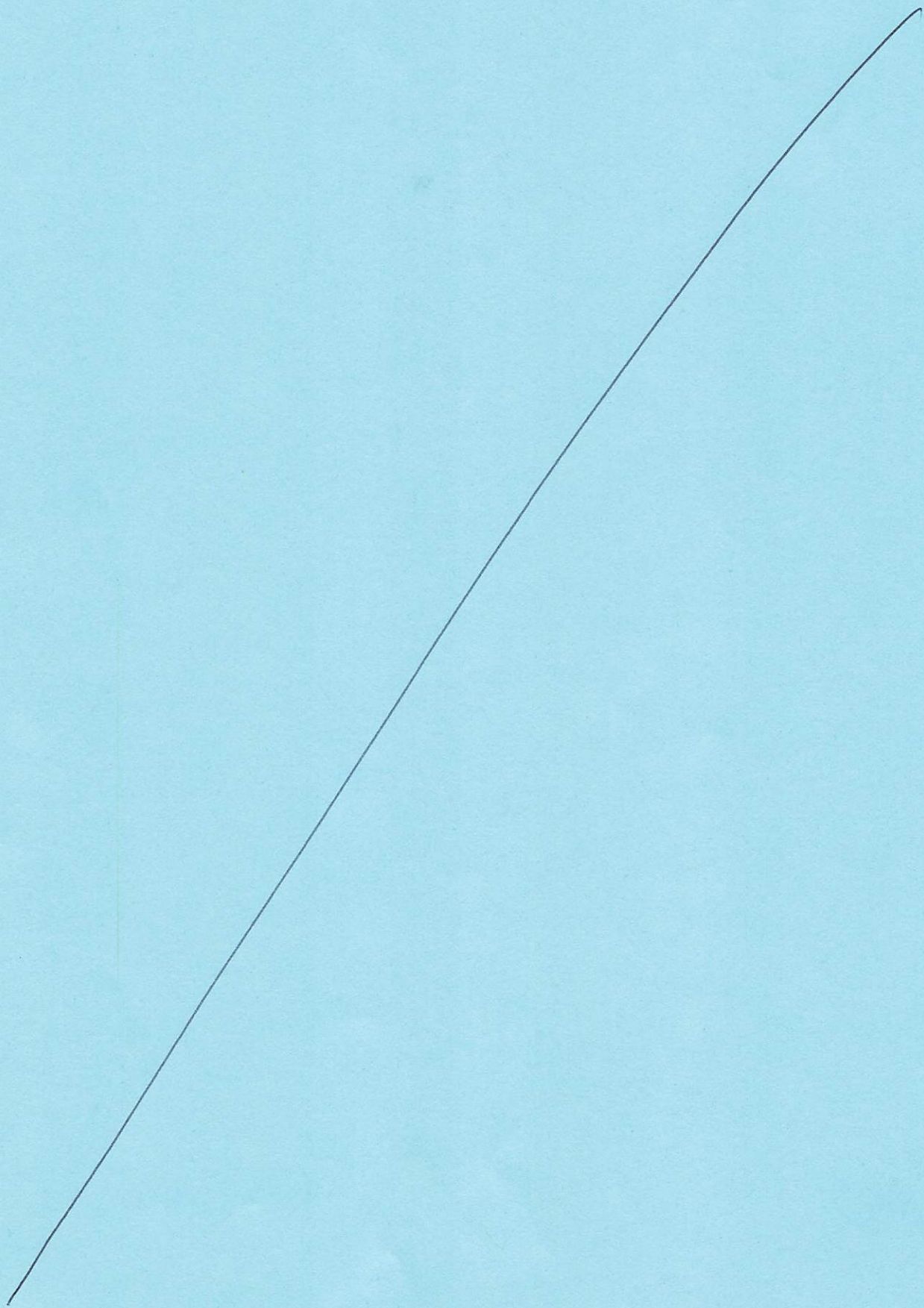

Yankee Ridge

The watershed between the streams flowing westward to Elk Fork and those flowing eastward, is a curved ridge that broadens to plateau proportions in places. It averages 900 ft. in height.

When Vinton Co. came into existence, the ridge was a thickly settled rural region, the settlers being mostly from New England. Sections 11, southeast corner of 10, north part of 14 and east sides of 15 and 22 composed Yankee Ridge.

Scarcely had McArthurstown been laid out (1815) with its five streets extending east and west across Market street, and with sixteen foot alleys giving access to back of everybody's lot, when newcomers began taking up land with the idea of farming. A few hardy souls had entered land earlier and were clearing it for cultivation. The Bothwells had settled west of where the town was later to be, in 1814. Jacob Shry and his brother Paul entered land in Elk Township as early as 1811. Levi Johnson came that same year and built the first horse mill. George Fry, a soldier of the War of 1812, came to Elk Township in 1816. Also in 1816, Edward Salts entered the land upon which the village of Dundas now stands.

By 1816 McArthurstown had a tannery, a shoemaker, a blacksmith shop, a general merchandise store, and the mail came once a week by horseback from Athens. There was no postoffice until 1828. After 1835 there was mail twice per week. Joel Sage built a tavern in 1816, where a stranger could find lodging and meals. All this was attractive to pioneers in the Ohio wilderness.

The village grew slowly, but Elk township from this time was settled rapidly. By 1840 there was no desirable government land left. Those coming later bought from ones who had entered it. The early comers had settled along the streams and on the lower land. There was much malaria, but the settlers did not know that it was caused by mosquitoes, but they knew the higher ground was more healthful. David Johnson, brother of Levi, went to the north side of Swan Township and took land for his homestead. They had come from Vermont. Others came from New England and settled on high land northeast of McArthur. In 1817 came Lemuel Lane and Thaddeus Fuller with their families to make their homes in Elk township, then a part of Athens County. The Lanes settled where the tableland that became known as Yankee Ridge, turns to the southward to terminate in the Gold Hill later famous for its coal mines, iron ore on the slopes and apple orchard on the summit. The terminal slope overlooking Elk Fork and the junction with Puncheon Fork that comes from the west, is a wild, wooded region that has always been the home of wild animals, principally foxes in recent years. The Fullers took land eastward from the Lanes, their farm sloping to a much lower level on the north.

Thaddeus Fuller had been a soldier of the Revolution in his youth, and a prisoner of war. He was the son of Benjamin Fuller who was descended from Robert Fuller of Dedham, Mass. Thaddeus lived until 1834, and was buried on his own land. The D.A.R. searched out the location and had a marker erected 1947. William Fuller was three years old when he came with his family to Elk Township. In 1837, he married Celesta Lane. She
