OAK GROVE CEMETERY, BOWLING GREEN, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO RELOCATION OF THOSE ENTOMBED IN THE OAK GROVE MAUSOLEUM, 10 Oct 1998

In 1909, Allen E. Avery, who owned land just west of the Oak Grove Cemetery in Bowling Green, Wood Co OH, built a mausoleum. Although privately owned until 1985, this mausoleum, which contained 384 crypts, has always been a public burial place. From its opening in 1910 until 1985, the mausoleum was owned and operated by the Bowling Green Mausoleum Association.

In 1985, ownership and operation of the mausoleum reverted from the Bowling Green Mausoleum Association to the City of Bowling Green by order of the Wood County Common Pleas Court. At the time the City took ownership, the mausoleum, which had already stood for 75 years, was in need of repair. The roof leaked badly, and the resulting infiltration of water had caused damage to the plaster ceiling, the stone walls, and the marble facings of many of the 384 crypts. Although the City took action to decelerate further deterioration of the building by making repairs to the roof, the safety of those visiting and walking past the mausoleum was a significant concern. Because of concerns about the structural integrity of the building and the high cost of renovation and continued maintenance to the aging structure, the City Council and Administration made the difficult determination to remove the bodies from the mausoleum and raze it.

Starting in the early 1990's, the City began work on a plan to remove the bodies from the mausoleum and re-bury them in the City-owned Oak Grove Cemetery. For many years, research was completed by the Wood County Chapter of The Ohio Genealogical Society and City staff, particularly Mrs. Georgia Willhite, to find descendants who were asked to give their consent to relocate the remains.

In 1997, the City awarded a contract to the locally-owned Dunn Funeral Home to remove the bodies from the mausoleum. The removal occurred in 1998. At that time, the City re-located 339 bodies. While a few bodies were moved to other cemeteries, most remained in Oak Grove. Some bodies were moved to individual family plots while the majority of those previously entombed in the mausoleum were moved to the formally undeveloped Northeast Corner. Each grave is marked with an individual granite marker. This section, hereafter known as the Mausoleum Corner of Oak Grove Cemetery, is located on the left when entering the cemetery from Merry Street.

The following pages have been compiled to commemorate the lives of those who lie buried here. Using information from mausoleum records, as well as much provided by both the City and Dunn Funeral Home staffs, Helen **Schumacher** diligently searched local newspapers of the past ninety years for obituaries and other related information about these former residents of the Bowling Green area. The final manuscript was prepared by Gibbie **Harms** and Lolita **Guthrie**.



Ralston is credited with Lot #3900 located at 343 Lincoln Avenue. He left the following children: Charles D., Martha C. ARKWRIGHT, Julia, Harriet, Mariah Fidelia, all of Youngstown; and Henry E., residence unknown.

A newspaper clipping from the *Youngstown Telegram*, filed with the estate packet advertises the estate and is directed to Henry E. RALSTON who was last known to be in Colorado City CO. The clipping is dated 8 Dec 1890.

packet, in one instance spelling out her first name as Mariah.

The estate was settled through a private sale of the goods and property of the deceased. Julia RALSTON purchased the real estate on Lincoln Ave. The firm of Drake & Pitts handled the funeral arrangements and payment was made to the Mahoning Cemetery Association for a "brick grave."

Henry **RALSTON**'s marriage to Margery **DAVIS** in Poland OH, 15 Mar 1843 by Jacob **COON** is also listed in the marriage records for Trumbull Co OH.² Henry **RALSTON** appears in the City Directories for Youngstown in 1875-1876 as a carpenter residing at Bryson near Lincoln Ave.³
