7 June **Darnell, Lewis J.** Died 2 June 1900 at Wichita, KS; Born 31 July 1839 Lewis Co, KY; Married Miss Clark; Six children, 5 living; widow survives; 3 children born in IN; 3 born in KS; moved to Clear Creek Twp., Payne Co. in 1887; daughter Hattie R. Darnell.

21 June **Bellamy, Mrs. Lou B.** at El Reno Fri, 15 June 1900; daughter of Mr. & Mrs. J.C. Jones of 6 miles east of Stillwater; Burial at Fairlawn Cemetery, Episcopal Church.

12 July **Withers, Charles** Killed in Ripley. He was resident of Rose twp; Age 26; son of Mr. and Mrs. A.G. Withers; leaves wife and 3 week old baby.

Hopkins, Miss Mae Died at her home in Cushing on Monday 9 July 1900.

Norris, Mrs. William of Stillwater died 8 July 1900. Remains were shipped to Rock Island, IL, Monday, 9 July 1900 for interment.

Huston, Capt. Member of the U.S. Army in the Philippines died a few days ago of fever. Formerly a resident of Guthrie.

Land, Mrs. George W. died Sat, 7 July 1900 at the family home just north of Stillwater. Burial in Fairlawn Cemetery, South Methodist Church.

Smith, infant child of Mr. and Mrs. Jobe Smith of Ingalls died last week.

Becker, Severenus died at his home in the southwest part of Stillwater Fri., 13 July 1900. Burial Sat., 14 July 1900 in Fairlawn Cemetery.

9 Aug **Ellis, Enos** of Pawnee Twp. died at his home 31 July 1900 at age 83 years. Born 1817; served in the Civil War Co. D 10 Regt. IN vols; moved to OK 1890 on NE 1/4 Sec 4 T19 N R4E; leaves wife and 2 children - Will Ellis and Mrs. Robert Ransdall. He was a civil war pensioner. Burial in Ingalls Cemetery.
I - Enos Ellis 8 Jan 1912-21 July 1900 Husb. of Sarah A

23 Sept **Platt, Dr.** son of Mr. and Mrs. H.L. Platt died at Picton, Ontario, 7 Sept 1900. He came to Stillwater in 1894 but was taken to his parents in Canada in Mar 1900 due to his sickness.

27 Sept **Brown, father of S.J. Brown** of Stillwater died in Illinois recently.

Vitz, Ed A butcher of Perry killed in Perry.

11 Oct **Whedby, J.H.** Served in Civil War Co. B 51 MO Vols; his widow survives; resolution on his death by Ladies of the GAR.

Brice, John Died 9 Oct 1900 at Ripley. Leaves one son, 2 daughters, all grown. One daughter lives in Stillwater with Mr. Brice's widowed sister, the other daughter lives in Enid and is married. The son is in the Indian School at Anadarko. Burial will be Friday, 12 Oct 1900 in Stillwater.

18 Oct **Andrews, Florence M.** daughter of Fobe Andrews died on Thursday, 11 Oct 1900 at age 4 months. Burial in Clarkson Cemetery next to mother who died two weeks ago.

25 Oct **Stafford, John** of near Morrison died near Perry Wed., 24 Oct 1900; age 61; leaves wife and one son; member of the Masonic Lodge.
FS - John J. Stafford 24 July 1840 - 24 Oct 1900

1 Nov **Leary, Katie O.** died Thursday, 25 Oct 1900 of quick consumption; age 25; buried in Fairlawn Cemetery through the Episcopal Church. Came to Stillwater from Everest, KS in May 1899 to live with cousin, Mrs. E.A. Lyons. She was also niece of Mrs. M.L. Walker.

15 Nov **Dun, R.G.** Died Sat, 10 Nov 1900 in New York. He was born in Chillicothe, OH in 1826. His wife survives. He was head of the Mercantile Agency firm of R.G. Dun & Co.

22 Nov **Burns, Bruce** In Collinsville, Indian Territory; second son of Judge Burns of Stillwater. Burial will probably be in Stillwater.

Doolin, Lydia Wife of William Doolin of Stillwater died Thursday, 22 Nov 1900 at age 67; burial will be Friday, 23 Nov 1900 in Fairlawn Cemetery. Leaves husband and several grown children including Mrs. J.B. Brock, Mrs. R.N. Andrews, and Lee Doolin, all of Stillwater.
FS - Lydia L Doolin died 22 Nov 1900 Age 63y 21d wife of William

29 Nov **Burns, Bruce** Son of Judge & Mrs. Burns died last week of Typhoid Fever and was buried in Collinsville.

Fultz, Tatum Killed in Kingman, TX. He was formerly of Stillwater and Ripley.

6 Dec **Morris, Violet** 3 year old daughter of Mr & Mrs Joe Morris. Died of croup Tuesday 4 Dec 1900. Funeral services were at the Christian Church Wed 5 Dec 1900.

Whiteside, Ernest Killed two miles north of Stillwater 6 Dec 1900. Whiteside had been in the grocery business in Illinois.

20 Dec **Hennigh**, child of Mr. and Mrs. A.F.Hennigh.

10 Jan **Day, May** Wife of W.B. Day died Sat, 5 Jan 1901 at home two miles east of Day, P.O. She died of pneumonia at age 62; buried Sunday 6 Jan 1901 at Sumner Cemetery. Leaves husband, 6 sons and 5 daughters.

17 Jan **Stevens, Jack** Widow of the late Jack Stevens has sold the Lexington "You Alls Doins" to his brother O. Jackson.

Cameron, Alice Wade Died 3 Jan 1901; born 1854 at Greensboro, Miss; moved to TX 1875; married in 1876. Leaves husband, 2 sisters, 5 children.

24 Jan **Myers, Wesley** Died 21 Jan 1901 at the home of his sister, Mrs. Augusta McGraw. He died of inflammation of the bladder; born 1825 in Brown Co., OH; In CA 35 years, from 1853; also lived in TX and KS. He was oldest of the family. Funeral was Tuesday, 22 Jan 1901 at the Presbyterian Church. Burial in Fairlawn Cemetery.

Wadsworth, Sam B. Died Sat, 19 Jan 1901 at Perry of typhoid pneumonia fever. He was Capt. in the Oklahoma National Guard. He was married two years ago to Nannie Harp of Stillwater.

31 Jan **Campbell, Alexander** Died at Winfield, KS 27 Jan 1901 of kidney problems; born 13 Apr 1836 in Northumberland Co, Canada; moved to Marysville, MO in 1868; to Beloit, KS in 1871; married 27 May 1875 in KS to Lillie E. Hillman; moved to Stillwater 1891. Funeral services by Rev. Nichols of Guthrie on Tuesday, 29 Jan 1901. Mr. Campbell was President of 1st National Bank of Stillwater and Director of Ripley State Bank; member of St. John's Commandery Knight Templars, St Andrews Episcopal Church; Frontier Lodge AF & AM. Leaves wife, one son, and one daughter.

Sharp, J.W. Died Sat, 26 Jan 1901 of pneumonia at age 51; leaves wife, 2 sons, 7 daughters. Funeral services Tues 29 Jan 1901 by Rev Tagne of the Christian Church; burial in Fairlawn Cemetery. Member Masonic Lodge and Ancient Order United Workmen.

7 Feb **McFarland**, infant child of Mr. and Mrs. John McFarland died Wed. 6 Feb 1901. Burial will be Thurs, 7 Feb 1901.

14 Feb **Prentiss, Maj. Gen. B.M.** Died 11 Feb 1901 at Bethany, MO. Hero of the battle of Shiloh and Mexican War Vet; supressor of the Mormon excitement in Illinois. He died of apoplexy.

14 Feb **Fisher, Mrs. H.D.** Wife of the veteran Methodist Preacher died on 12 Feb 1901 in Topeka, KS.

Hall, Rillie Wife of George Hall of six miles northeast of Stillwater, died Mon, 11 Feb 1901 of consumption. Funeral on 12 Feb; burial in Fairlawn Cemetery.

DeCamp, George 22 year old son of Job DeCamp died Sat, 9 Feb 1901 of consumption. Burial in Fairlawn.
FS - George W DeCamp 2 Sept 1878 - 12 Mar 1900

Terrill, Ira N. died in KS about 4 months ago.

Harden, Winnie Age 15, died in her home in Arkansas City, KS on 15 Feb 1901.

Loomiller, J.C. Killed 15 Feb 1901 in Princeton, IN. He was from Guthrie.

28 Feb **Lester, infant child of Mr. and Mrs. C. Lester** of near Glencoe died last Friday, 22 Feb 1901 and was buried Sat 23 Feb 1901.

Mulkey, Thomas Age 22, died Fri, 22 Feb 1901 at his home near Yale. Buried in Yale Cemetery Sat, 23 Feb 1901.

McFarland, Clark M. Age 54, died Sunday, 24 Feb 1901 at his home 4 miles south of Stillwater. Born in 1847 in OH; moved to OK in 1891. Funeral 25 Feb 1901, burial in Elm Grove Cemetery.

Crozier, Maj. I.N.F died in Cushing Mon, 25 Feb 1901, burial in Ontario, Canada.

Clark, O.A. Died Tuesday, 26 Feb 1901 at his home near Perkins of "inflammatory of the aryn". Born 1847; county surveyor; leaves no family but leaves estate worth over \$15,000.

Jones, Armistead Age 92, died Wed, 27 Feb 1901 at home of his son, P.A. Jones 11 miles northeast of Stillwater. He died of Brights disease; leaves 4 children.

McMichael, Thomas Died last week at his home at Plattsburg, MO. He was a resident of Ripley.

Sweet, Isaac of near Cordell, died Fri, 22 Feb 1901 of heart trouble.

7 Mar **Clark, O.A.** of near Perkins, died a few days ago. Body taken to Minneapolis, MN for burial. Two possible heirs to estate are Miss Clark of Chicago, a niece, and Mr. Crone of Tennessee.

Hahn, Valentine Killed by train on Thursday morning at the 6th Avenue crossing.

Weaver, J.S. Died Thursday, 28 Mar 1901 in Perkins of hemorrhage of the bowels. Born 1857 in Wayne Co., IN. Moved to KS in 1875; to Payne Co. in spring 1899; was lawyer in Perkins. Leaves wife and nephew J.E. Chamness of Stillwater.

Lucas, Alice Daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Clayton Lucas died east of Cleveland at age 3.

Bates, J. Age 64, of 3 miles east of Stillwater, died Mon, 4 Mar 1901 of stomach cancer. Burial in Fairlawn Cemetery on Wed 6 Mar 1901. Leaves two daughters and one son.

Middleton, Sylvester Age 51, of 8 miles northwest of Stillwater, died Tuesday, 5 Mar 1901 of heart trouble. Moved to OK from Lynn Co, KS in 1894. Leaves wife and 2 sons.
L - S. Middleton 10 Sept 1840 - 5 Mar 1901

14 Mar **Foote, Charles** Conductor of the Rock Island local freight, killed at Hennessey Thurs., 7 Mar 1901. Remains taken to Caldwell where he will be buried and where his family lives.

Daily, John Scouting companion of Kit Carson is dead at his home in Butler Co, KS. He was a soldier in the Mexican War.

Armstrong, Grandpa of Elm Grove died Thursday, 7 Mar 1901. Services held Sat, 9 Mar 1901 by Rev. Dumas.

Hasket, Mrs. R.J. Age, 28, died at her home six miles northwest of Stillwater, Monday, 11 Mar 1901, of pneumonia fever. Leaves husband and four children. Burial in Fairlawn Cemetery.

Jones, Daniel Farmer of Preston, frozen to death in the prairie during a blizzard. He was a veteran of the Civil War.
