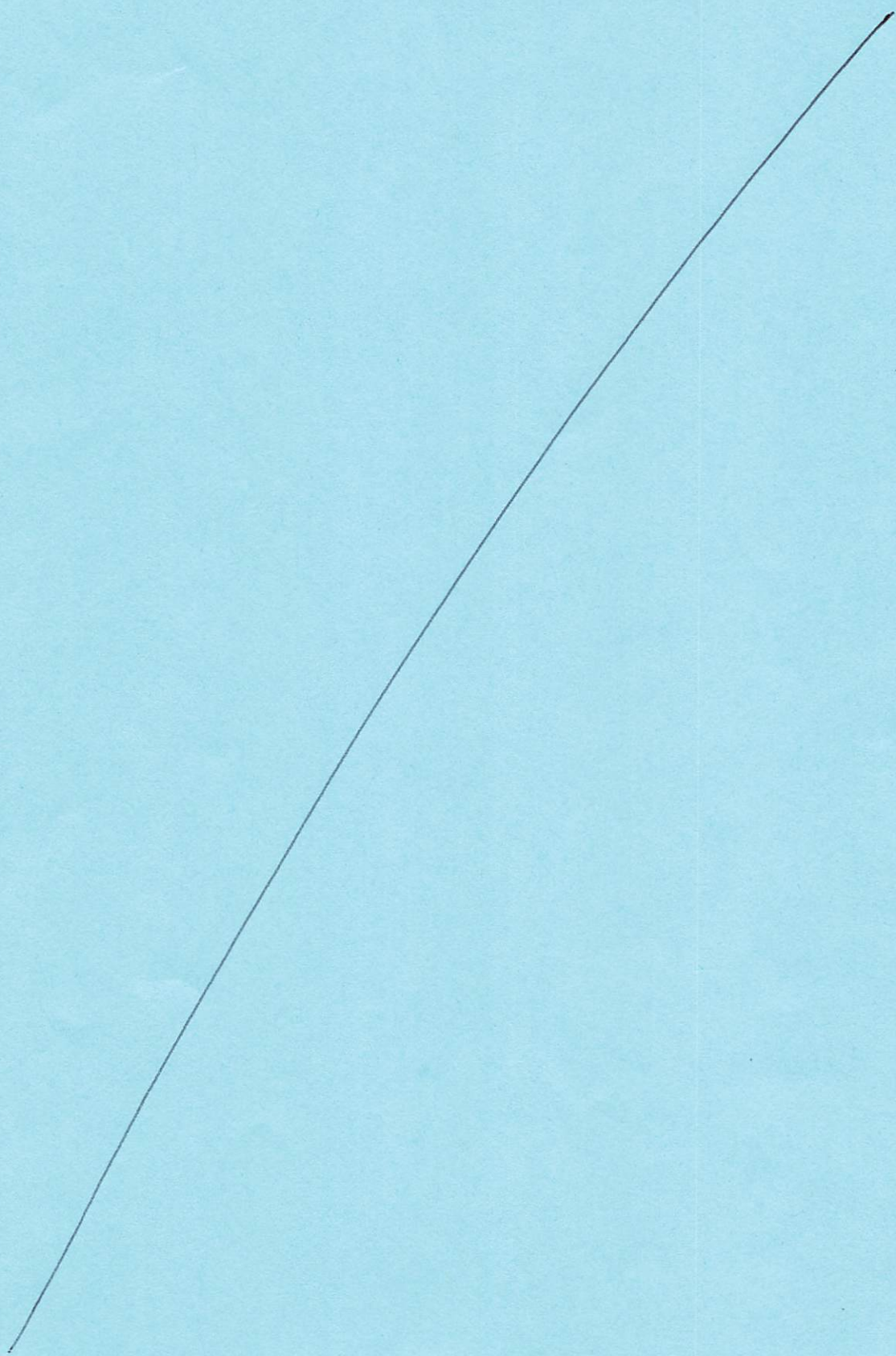

The North Powder Cemetery is located on the Northeast city limits of North Powder. The land on which the old cemetery is located, was given to the City, in 1890, by I. N. Sanders from a portion of his property. There is no plat for this old cemetery and there are numerous unmarked graves.

Prior to 1890, there was an old cemetery located about one mile northwest of North Powder, near the foothills near Wolf Creek. Some of the graves from this cemetery were moved to the new location; evidence of others are still there. In 1925, land for a new addition was purchased.

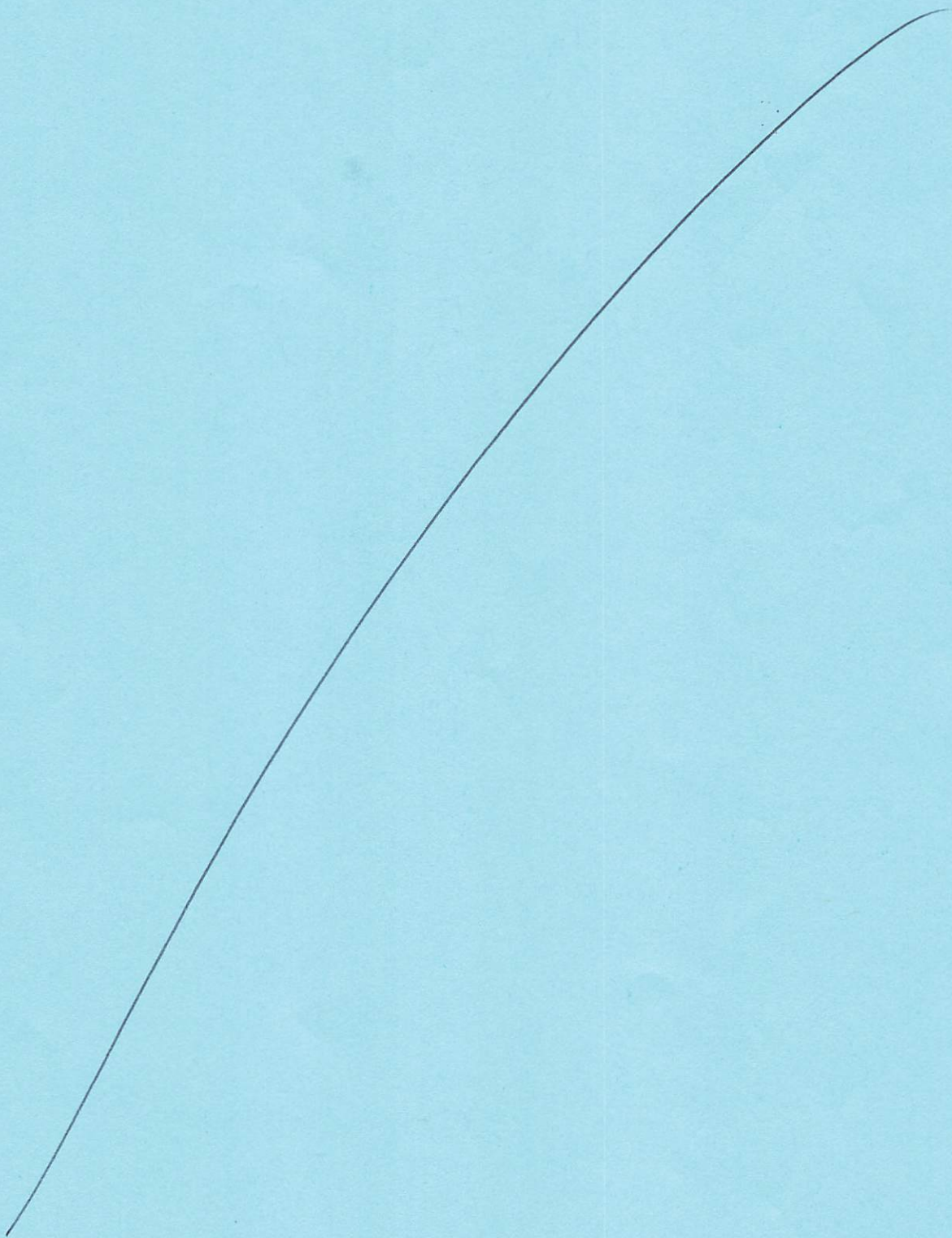
