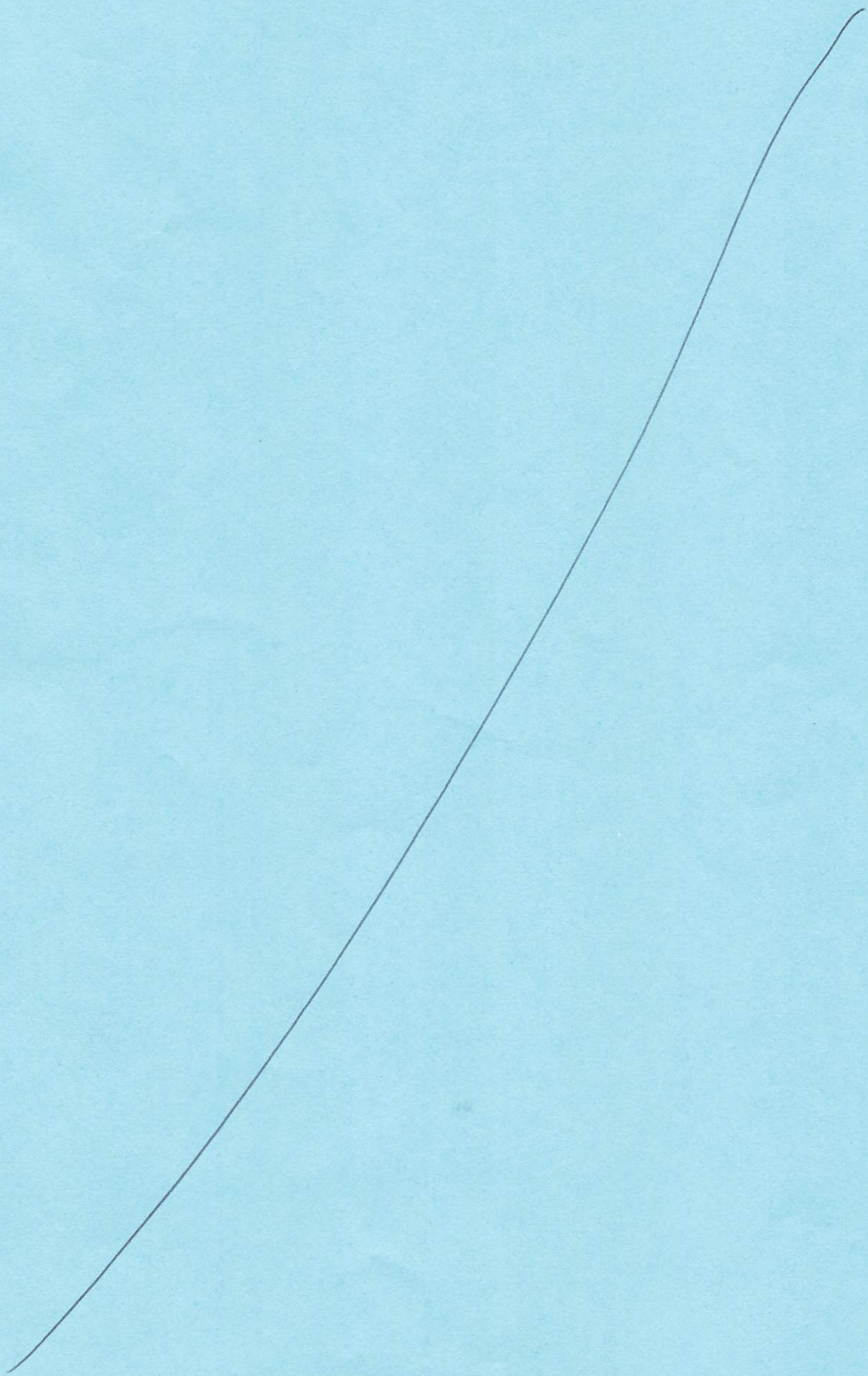


CHARLES JACOBUS SCHOOL, First Ward

Births and Deaths in the Allegheny City Home

Lists and Indexes to the Legal, Court, and Municipal Records of Allegheny County, PA contains an article entitled "Births and Deaths in the Allegheny City Home, 1871-1904".¹ Although the title implies that records are available from 1871 through 1904, no births or deaths were listed within the article for the years 1871-1880, 1882-1889, and 1898-1904.

The introduction to the article in *Lists and Indexes* is as follows:

The Allegheny City Home and Farm for the poor was established in 1844 by the Commonwealth legislature (April 9, 1844 P.L. 226) for the purpose of providing a home and place to work for the poor of the city. Between 1871 and 1873 a new home was built in Clarendon. The home was under the administration of the directors of the poor that after 1890 became the directors of charities. The home itself had male and female adults and children. A minority portion of the population were considered insane. The following lists derive from the directors' annual reports published as part of the annual reports of Allegheny City. There are separate lists for births and deaths for each year. The birth record provides the mother's name, the infants' sex and birth date. The death record provides the name of the person, his/her age, the date of death, and the cause of death. Both lists end in 1897 after which the records provide registration number rather than name.

If the original volumes of annual reports of Allegheny City are examined, births and deaths are found for many of the years missing in the above article.² A few deaths are mentioned in "Accounts" and "Physician's Reports" between 1871 and 1876. Full death records begin in 1877; birth records do not begin until 1880. No names are listed for the years after 1897 (see introduction above). The following article completes the birth and death records from the *Annual Reports of Allegheny City*.

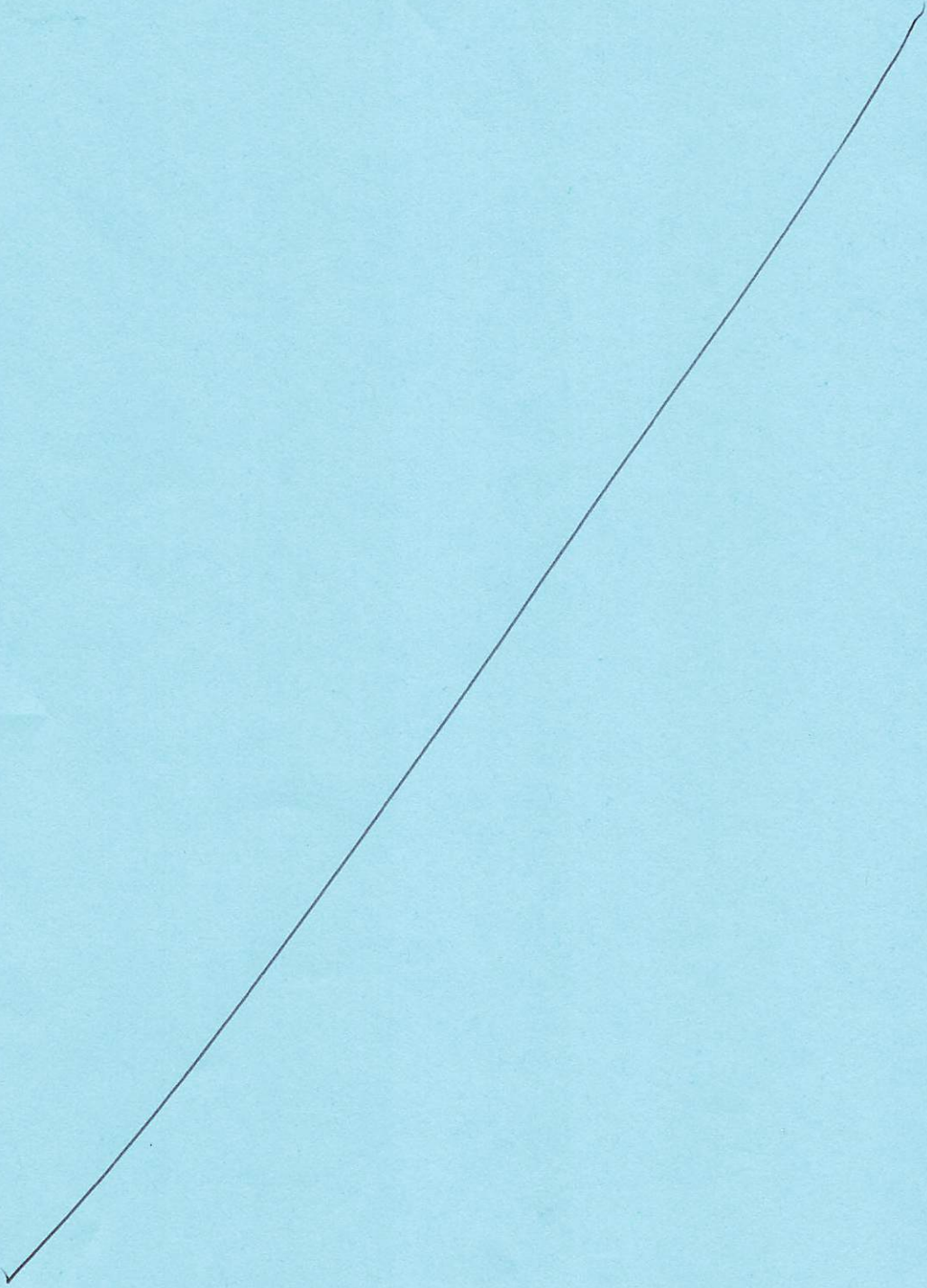

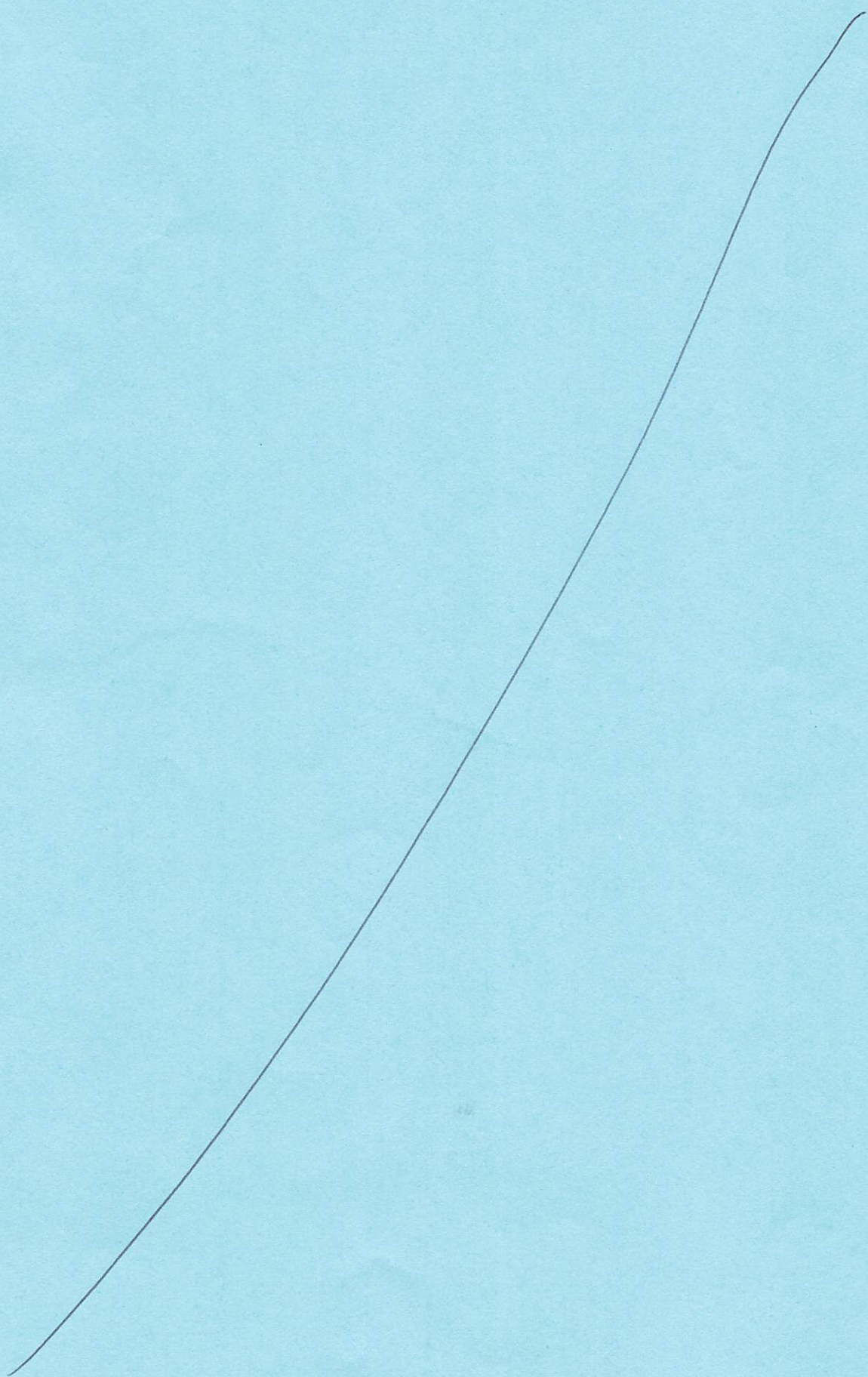

Historischer Fragebogen (historical questionnaires) from the records of the First German Baptist Church (Erste Deutsche Baptisten-Gemeinde), located on the Southside of Pittsburgh 1862-1918, were described in the *Western Pennsylvania Genealogical Society Quarterly Volume 33:3, 2007*. That article listed an extraction of the birth dates and places for immigrant members of the church born before 1900 in Germany and Eastern Europe based on the Historischer Fragebogen. Recently two parish register books for First German Baptist have also been located at Temple Baptist Church in Mount Oliver.

This article presents an extraction of marriages and births of children through 1905 as listed in the Historischer Fragebogen with supplemental information from the parish register books. However, this extraction from the First German Baptist Church records is not limited to marriages performed in that church. Marriages with dates and locations have been extracted from surviving records for members of the church regardless of where the marriages were performed, including many marriages in Germany.

Not all marriages listed in Pittsburgh were performed by pastors of the First German Baptist Church; pastors of other churches are listed as well. Moreover, marriages performed by pastors of Protestant churches in Pittsburgh were often not performed in the church. The marriage of David Hamel and Amelia Eckhardt was performed by L H Donner, the pastor of First German Baptist in 1889, at the 'minister's residence'; and the marriage of Karl Baier (Charles Beier) and Mary Sajenga was officiated by Rev. Donner at the 'Bride's Residence'.¹ Charles Beier died in 1902 in Pittsburgh in Municipal Hospital (the infectious disease hospital) from smallpox and was buried in South Side Cemetery the day following his death.²

This extraction is not a complete list of marriages and births recorded in the surviving church records. In addition to limiting this extraction from the Historischer Fragebogen by date, only marriages for which the spouses, date and place were given are listed here; the church records include further information on marriage for other

members of the church. Therefore, the researcher is encouraged to search for further entries in the original records, especially in the parish register books.

It is necessary to emphasize that this extraction is based on the Historischer Fragebogen and is not a complete list from the parish register books. The handwriting, especially the old German script in the parish register books, is often difficult to interpret, and the researcher is encouraged to confirm the listing in the original records. There were two marriages where separate church records for the two spouses listed different marriage dates, and an identification of 'II' indicates a second marriage for one of the partners. The notation 'kinder' means that births of offspring are listed in the church records. Births of offspring are quoted here in years only, though exact dates are listed for most births in the original records.

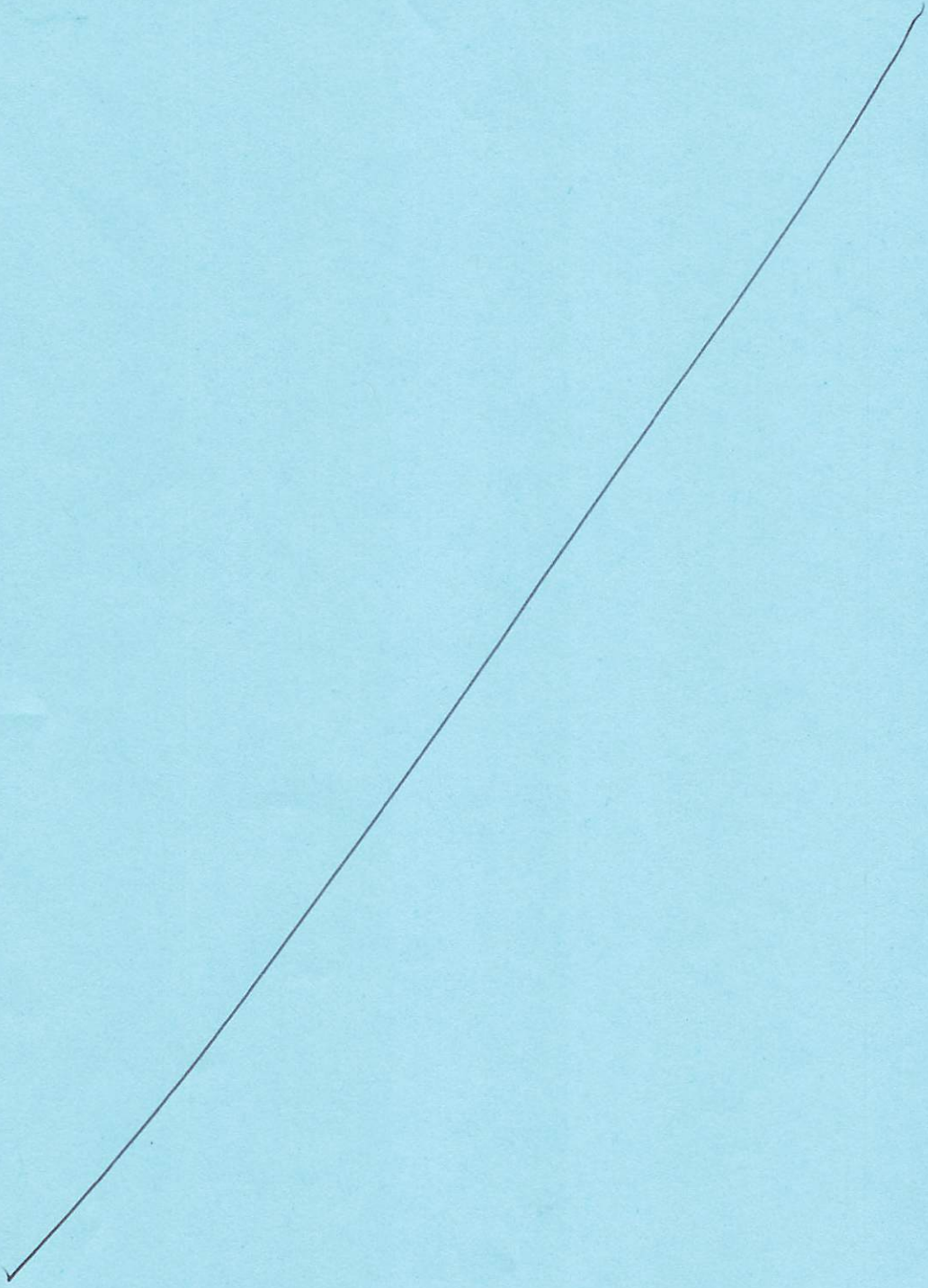

In 1829, a group of Methodists in Allegheny City formed a class and met in McIlhaney's Tannery and later in Eichbaum's Oil Factory. In November 1831, the Board of Trustees purchased property and erected a one-story frame building at Beaver and North Diamond Streets. After the construction of the building, the Pittsburgh Conference of the Methodist Episcopal Church appointed Reverend Alfred Brunson as the first pastor in 1832.

The Congregation was known as the Alleghenytown Methodist Episcopal Church until 1838, when several members withdrew to organize the South Commons Methodist Episcopal Church. The former congregation was then referred to as the Beaver Street Methodist Episcopal Church. The name was changed again in 1872 when the Borough of Allegheny changed the name of the street to Arch.

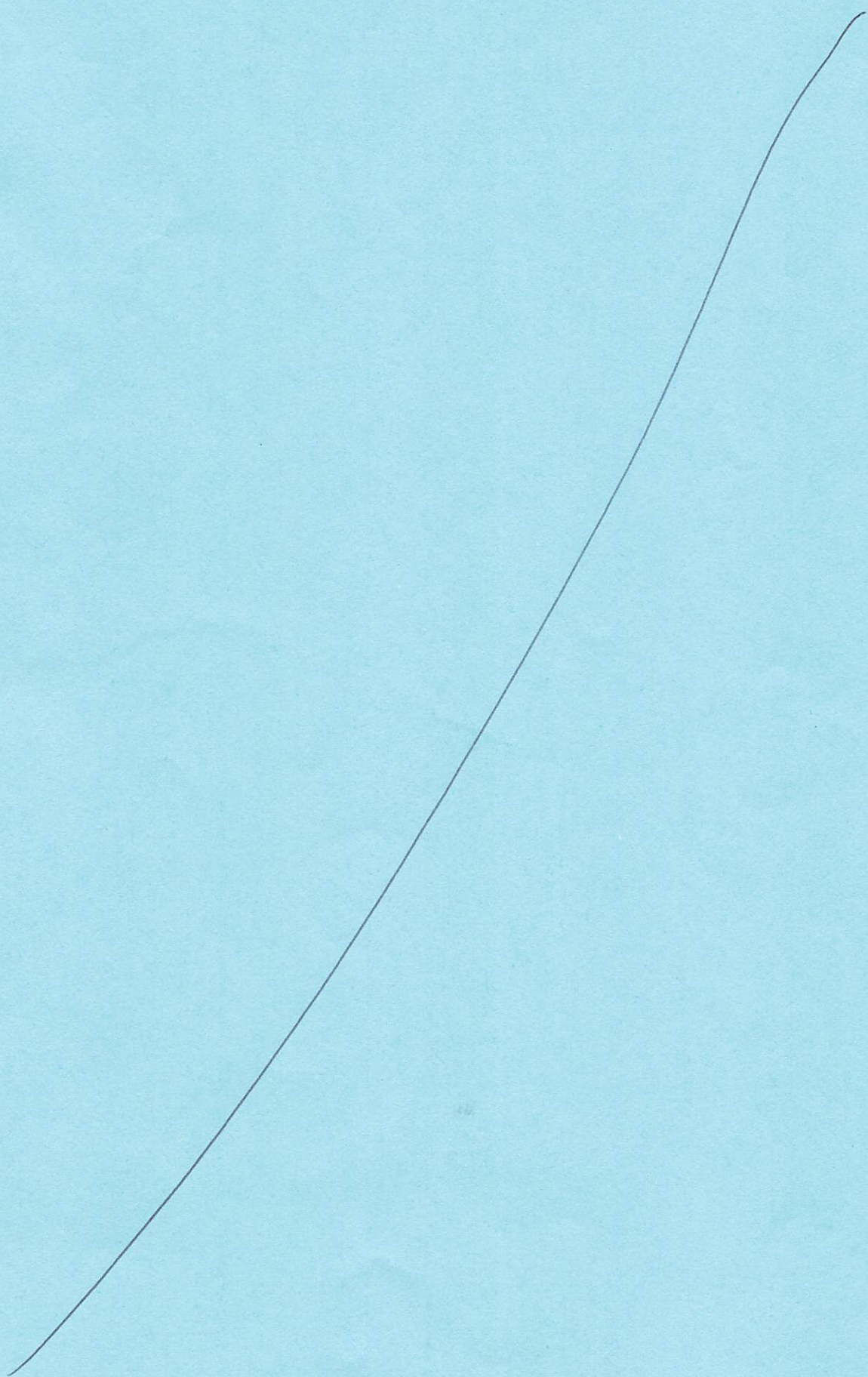
