James and Annie Kennedy Bryan

James Bryan was born April 23, 1864 in Dalmellington, Ayshire, Scotland. He appears in the 1881 census for Scotland in a large household in Craigie Farms, Scotland, where he was employed as a farmhand. Also living there was Ann Kennedy, age 17, occupation general domestic servant. Annie was the daughter of John and Elizabeth Edgar Kennedy and was born April 28, 1863 in Dalmellington, Scotland.

James and Annie were married on December 31, 1881 and their first three children, Grace, James R. and John Kennedy were born in Scotland. The family immigrated to the United States in 1887, probably due to the harsh economic conditions in Scotland. Two of Annie's brother, John and Hugh Kennedy, followed soon afterwards. Records in the Greene County Courthouse state that the three men intended to become naturalized on June 21, 1889, and the certificates of naturalization were granted on June 25, 1892. Annie's mother, now a widow, appears in the 1900 United States census for Washington County, PA. she was living in California, PA next to her son Hugh, his wife Elizabeth and their son William.
