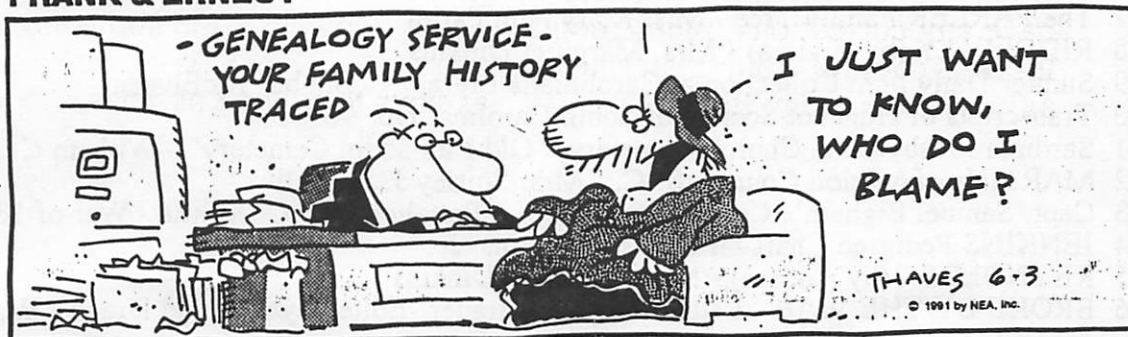


GRAVES OF REVOLUTIONARY SOLDIERS AND PATRIOTS
