On the 7th of September 1846 there was begun before the Hon. R. E. B. Baylor, Judge; Samuel Grimmett, Sheriff and Lem G. Clepper, Clerk, the following proceedings:

Henry H. Goff, Petitioner, represents that he emigrated to the county in 1824 and has been and is a resident & citizen of same and that he was and still is unmarried, that he did volunteer in the service of Texas against Mexico in 1835, and before and after that time, he obeyed the call to service and that it was not until after the Battle of San Jacinto and the capture of Santa Anna that he went to the States on business which detained him there several months, but at no time did he refuse to participate in the war, nor did he aid or assist the enemy. He says that he has obtained a Certificate from The Board of Commissioners of this country for one-third of a League of Land, but the Commissioners are to investigate the land offices and have not reported the same as genuine. He says he has made no other application for his headright than the one just stated nor has received any other certificate of title to his quantum of land, to which he feels entitled to under the Constitution and for which he has applied. He asks for relief. Megginson & Smyth for Petitioner. Case began in March 1844, extended to Spring of 1844 by agreement and the consent of the Court, and was continued to Fall Term 1845 and thereafter to trial before a jury at the Fall Term of 1846.

At the trial by jury, the State was represented by S. D. Hay and C. W. Buckley, Esq. and the Plaintiff by Megginson and Smyth. The jury was composed of R. J. Silver, Merv Whittiker, William Simonton, J. T. Hall, Rolly Rogers, M. Fields, Charles Weaver, Appleton Gay, J. S. Betts, John Womack, George W. Brooks and Richard S. Willis. Foreman A. Gay, announced the verdict of the jury in favor of Plaintiff who was awarded his 1/3rd League of Land, and Plaintiff to pay all costs of suit.



Simonton of the County and State aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge every part thereof, and we do acquit and discharge the said Robert S Simonton his heirs executors, administrators and assigns and every of them by these presents: hath granted, bargained sold, aliened, remise, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do fully freely and absolutely grant bargain sell, alien, remise release convey confirm and assure unto the said Robert S. Simonton his heirs and assigns forever, all that tract or parcel of land towit- lying and being situate in said County of Montgomery in the State aforesaid and being the West half of a Two Hundred and Twenty acre tract of land deeded by William C. Clarke to Margaret Shannon on the 24th day of September 1835 (which Two hundred and twenty acres a part of a Six Hundred Acre tract of land bought by said Wm. C. Clarke of John Corner on the 15th day of September 1835 and a part of the League of Land, granted to the said John Corner by the State of Coahuila and Texas) and afterwards sold & transferred to Owen Shannon by the said Margaret Shannon on the 17th day of May 1847 and from the said Owen Shannon me on the 13th day of March 1848-

Beginning at the "the" South West corner of said survey, running East One Hundred and ten poles or Six Hundred fifty three and four tenths varas-







haveing I heard from you about a month ago though a letter from Brother William and where to direct letters we are all well and getting along tolerable well for these hard times. I am living to myself and trying to farm and getting along badly enough. I had a trifling man hired who managed my crop in such a way that I will have to turn out part of it. I have not comenced chopping cotton the second time I expect you are nearly ready to lay by yours as vegetation is more forward where you are liveing than it is here I hope you are getting on well none of us here never knew what hard times were before and if we have war everything will be getting worse instead of better when I parted with you at Galveston I expected to see you before I left there but I am affraid now that I never will see you again but we can write to each other I want you to write to me as often as you can and I will be sure to answer all your letters how do you like the Country you are liveing do you think I could do better there than here for I do not own any land I am renting land poor at that and if it dont rain soon I am affraid I will not make the corn I planted what are you doing for a livelyhood farming or not I hope your prospects are good one of brother Isaacs sons was here last summer and promised to come and live with me but did not I do not know what is the reason I expect he has gone to war as all the young men of our country have gone or nearly so. the war fever runs high in this State I expect it is the same where you are write to me soon and as often as you can I heard from Sister Catherine Just before Christmas she was liveing in Prattville
