On November 13, 1974, Mary Harper Stone (Mrs. J.N.), Georgetown, granddaughter of Dr. G.S.C. Harper, gave the following additional information:

"Dr. Harper's full name was George Smither Coleman Harper. He was one of Georgetown's pioneer doctors. His son, Samuel George Harper, also became a doctor and practiced in Georgetown. He is buried in the IOOF Cemetery", (aka Georgetown City Cemetery).

Mrs. Stone also stated that a Mr. Roman, who worked for Mrs. Harper, is buried in the family cemetery, but has no stone marker.

In addition, she believes that a Negro slave who was brought to Georgetown by the Price family is also buried there. She did not know his name.

News was received here yesterday of the death at his home in Calhoun county, Texas, of Mr. W. February 28, 1902

Died in Missouri

On February 23, 1902, at her home in Marthaville, Mo.; Mrs. Emily Lavender, died and was laid to rest beside her husband at Jonesburg, Mo. Mrs. Lavender was born in Franklin county, Virginia, and moved to Missouri in 1868 where she reared a large family. She was a consistent member of the Methodist church and her lovable christian character was admired by all who knew her. She was a sister of Mr. M. G. Noble, of Georgetown, and a mother of Messers Joe N. and Moses G. Lavender, formerly of this city.

February 28, 1902

Death of Maybelle Fasel

On last Tuesday morning Maybelle, the nine-months old baby girl of Mr. and Mrs. Joe H. Fasel, died very suddenly with a convulsion. The baby had been

sick but not considered dangerous and when seized died before a physician arrived. The little one was laid to rest in the Odd Fellows cemetery on Wednesday, Rev. R. E. Morris, pastor of the First Baptist church, conducting the funeral services. The devoted parents have the sympathy of all but are consoled with the words of the blessed Christ who said "Suffer little children to come unto me and forbid them not; for of such is the Kingdom of Heaven."

March 2, 1902

Death of Dr. Richards

Dr. Sam R. Richards died on Tuesday morning, March 4, 1902, after a long and continued illness. Funeral services were conducted at the residence of Mr. and Mrs. J. J. Cluck, by Dr. M. C. Hutton and Rev. R. E. Morris, and his remains were then conveyed to Austin, and were laid to rest beside his wife. Dr. Richards was born in 1836, in Langharve, South Wales. He was married in 1869 to Mrs. Lenora Gillis, of New Orleans, La. He leaves two sons, D.L. and W. E. Richards. When death was approaching he remarked: "I will fight no more -- if anymore is done will be by the grace of God." Peace to his ashes.

March 2, 1902

Death of Mr. W.M. Faubion

On Friday, February 28, 1902, Mr. Wm. M. Faubion died at his home near Leander, Texas, from the effects of pneumonia and complications following. He was buried on Saturday, a large funeral

concourse of sorrowing relatives and friends following the remains to the last resting place. He was born in Coke county, Tennessee, in 1835, came to Texas in 1855, and has lived many years near old Bagdad, this county where he won the respect and confidence of all. He was married to Miss Malinda Black, who survives him.

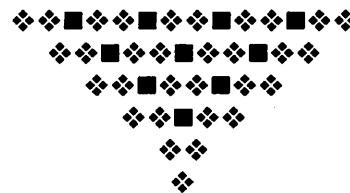

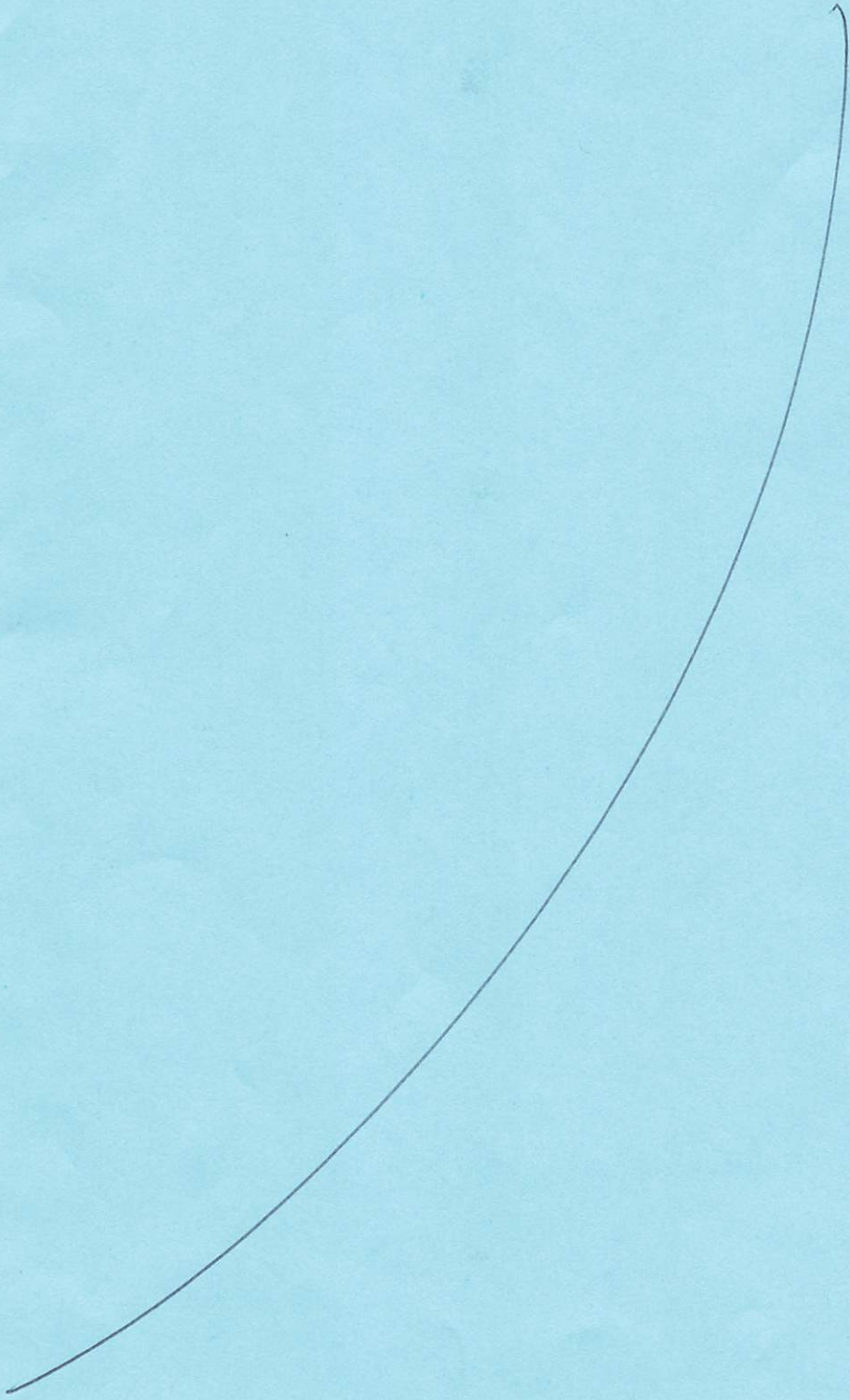

Located just west of Andice, Williamson Co., TX, on FR 970, it is approx. 2 miles east of US Hwy. 183. In the past, this cemetery has been called Pilot Knob Cemetery and White House Graveyard. The Andice Cemetery Association was organized in 1956. It meets annually on the first Sunday in May at the school.

For easier reference, names are approximately alphabetical by surname. The first date under a name is date of birth, the next is date of death; if there is a third date, it is the marriage date. In a few instances, the marriage location is shown instead of the date. To make this index as complete as possible, we checked a survey done in the 1970's, Harold Asher's book entitled "Andice History", cemetery maps, notes from the cemetery association president, and information at the Georgetown library. The information on all readable gravestones is included, even people we believe may still be living. This index also contains some information not shown on the gravestones, but known to the surveyors from research or provided by relatives. There are a number of unmarked graves; where possible, information is included regarding the unmarked graves.

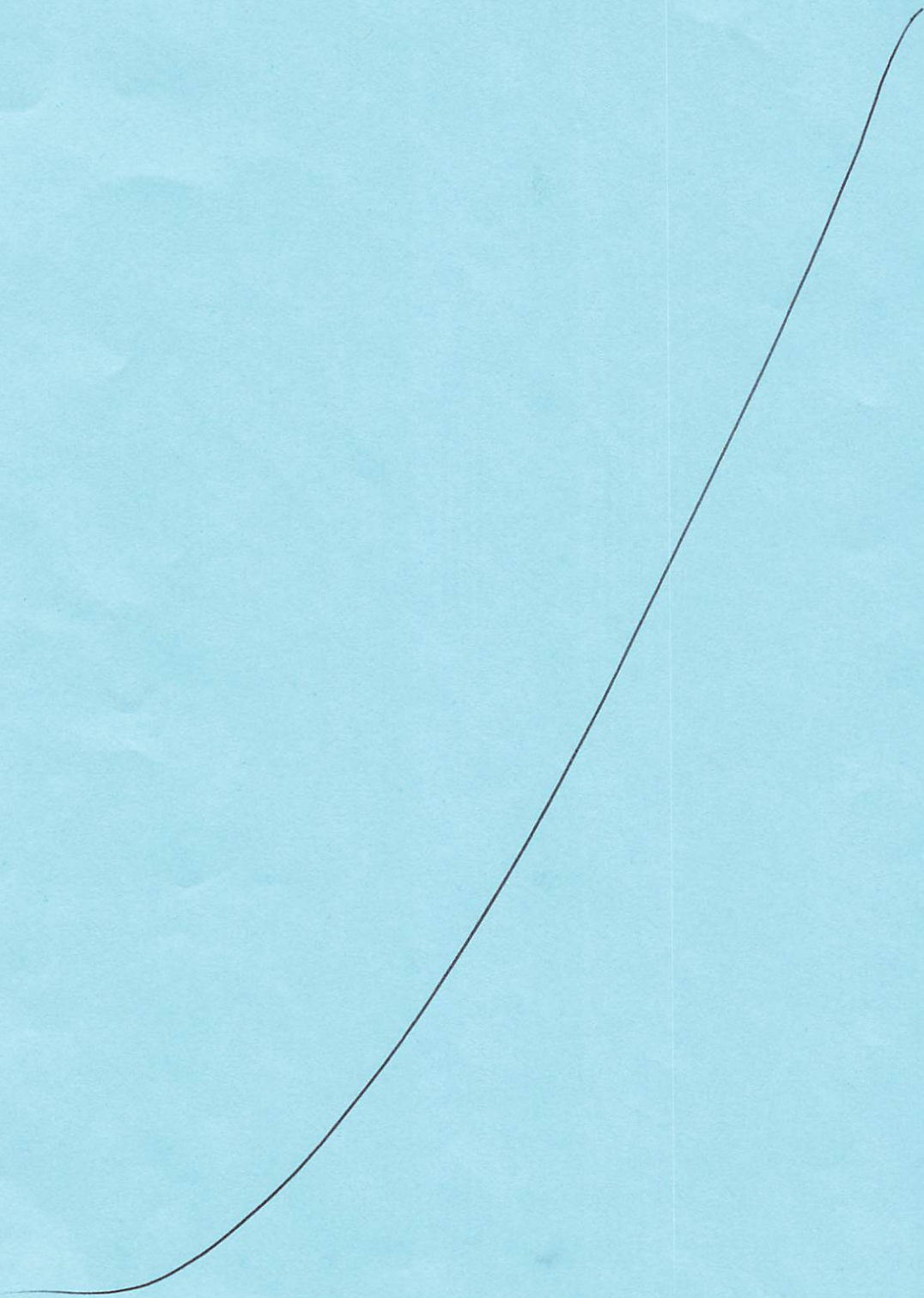

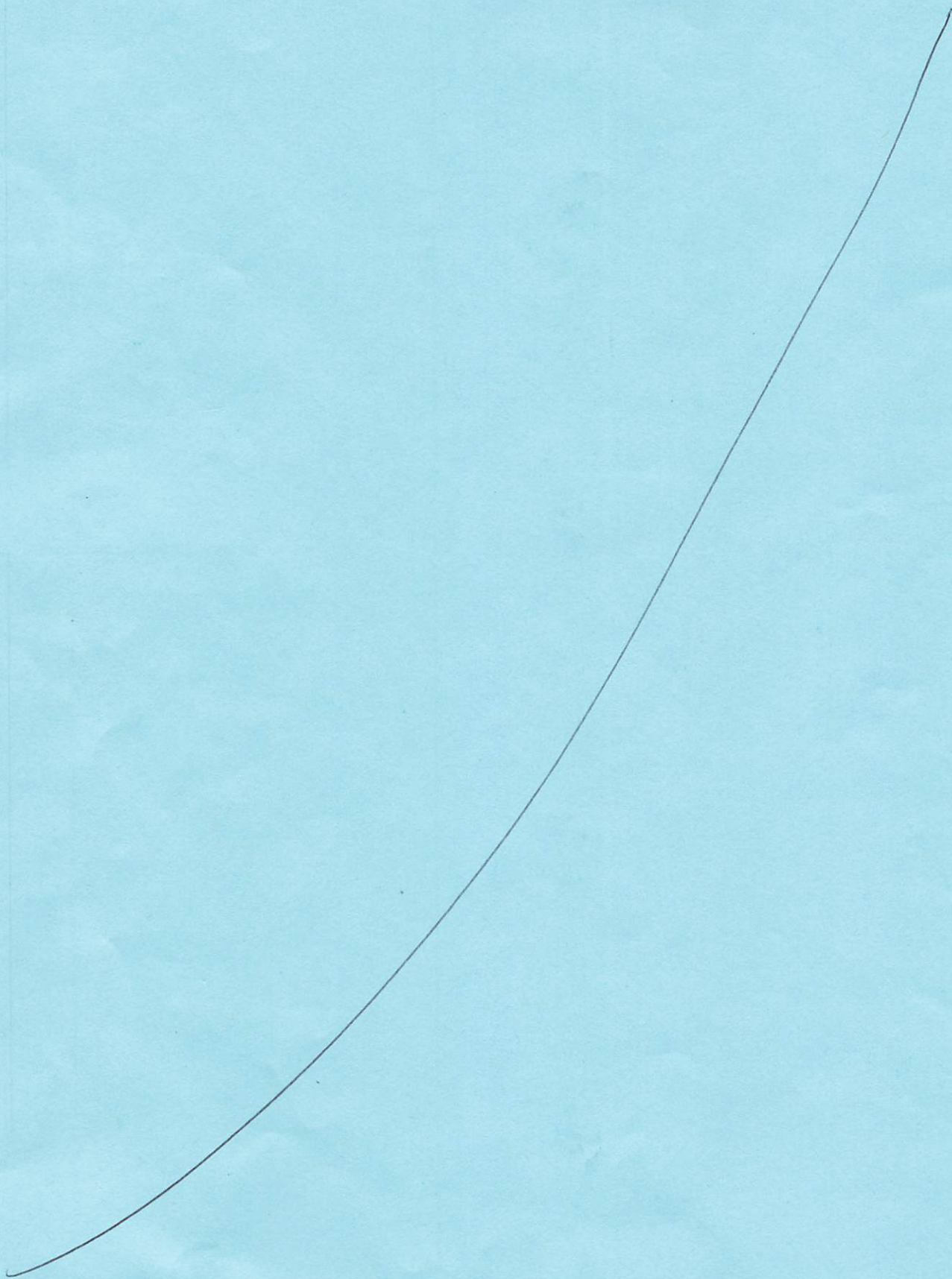
