#### **Raising CAIN in the MARKS Family**

Finding the Cain connection to my Marks family begins with Nicholas Cain (1693-1787) who married Catrina "Catherine" Mohn "Mann" (1705-1763/80) in 1732, both bom in Germany. He had previously been married to a Margaret who reportly died in 1732 enroute to America. From his marriages came children Daniel (1743-1851) m/1 ?Susannah Custer? and m/2 Sarah Knight 1814; Margaret m. John Shaw; James A. (1739-1836) m. Elizabeth Custer (1751-1818); John J. (1742-1834) m. ?Charity Booth?; Cornelius (?1747?) m. Sarah Hyatt 1798; Edmond m. Mary "Polly" Custer abt 1767; Jesse m/1 Elizabeth Edwards 1778, m/2 Mary Fox 1796; Anna "Anne" m. ?Hipple?; David m. a Custer; Urich Wilhelm, and Nicholas, Jr., a Lt., Virginia Line. Of these, Daniel, Private, Virginia Regiment, 1st Line, 1779-1780, leads to the Marks line.

Daniel had children Catherine (1766-1851) m. Robert Lowther 1787; John G. (1769-1857) m/1 Näncy White 1769, m/2 Catherine Haverty 1826; James (1771-1853) m. Ruth Dotson; Cornelius (1773-1798) m. Margaret Sleeth 1798; Mary (1779-1854) m. David Cain, son of her Uncle John; Amold(1776) m/1 Elizabeth Tanner 1791, m/2 Mary Lockhard 1851, m/3 Pleasant Jane Chapman 1829; Emmaline m. James Tucker 1837; Hester (1817-1895) m. Allen Graffy 1839; Jemima M. William Butler 1838; John V. (1769-71835?) m/1 Mary Ann Young 1834, mi/2 Mary A. Roberts 1844; Wesley m. Louisa Thompson 1838; and Sarah "Sally" (1799) m. Moses Shinn. Of these, Cornelius continues the line to the Marks family.

Cornelius had among his children Sarah (5/8/1816-Jan/Apr 1892) who married Morgan Marks (8/11/1814-5/24/1892) in Harrison County, [W]VA 8/22/1840. From that marriage came several children, including John Westley Marks (6/9/1848-2/10/1919) sho married Rachel Ann Harper (11/12/1852-1/31/1946) on 7/4/1867. From there the line goes to Carson Roscoe Marks to Berea G. Marks to the author.

The Marks Ancestor Chart was published in *The Journal*, Spring 2001. Other related *Journal* articles are the following issues: Aug 78, Sept/Oct 79, Nov 79, Apr 81, Jan 82, Apr 82, Apr 84, and Aug 86

#### Notes from Other Societies

Some interesting statistics from the Ventura County Genealogical Society as published in thier Newsletter of November 2005. This is the way it was 100 years ago:

The average life expectancy in the U.S. was 47 years.

Only 14 per cent of the homes in the U.S. had bathtubs.

Only 8 percent of the homes had a telephone.

A three-minute call from Denver to New York City cost eleven dollars.

There were only 8000 cars in the U.S., and there were only 144 miles of paved roads.

The maximum speed limit in most cities was 10 MPH.

The tallest structure in the world was the Eiffel Tower.

The average wage in the U.S. was 22 cents per hour.

A competent accountant could expect to earn \$2000 per year, a dentist \$2500 per year, a veterinarian between \$1500 and \$4000 per year and a mechanical engineer about \$5000 per year.

More than 95 percent of the births took place at home.

Ninety percent of the doctors had no college education. Instead they attended so-called medical schools, many of which were condemned by the press and by the government were labeled as sub-standard.

The population of Las Vegas, Nevada was only 30!

Crossword puzzles, canned beer and iced tea had not been invented.

Only 6 percent of Americans graduated from high school.

Eighteen percent of the households in the U.S. had at least one full time servant or domestic help. There were about 230 reported murders in the entire U.S.

### Genealogy Mistakes

I thought that it might be helpful to remind our readers of some of the mistakes we make as genealogists. Probably one of the biggest errors we can commit is failure to:

### USE STANDARD GENEALOGICAL FORMS

This probably sounds like a "no brainer" but it's surprising how many people doing family research do not have the simplest of forms. I've seen a researcher some to the library with her ancestor chart written on the back of a pizza box and upside down. Most of these family searchers are new and need some basic help.

The <u>Ancestor Chart</u> is available on most computer programs and is probably, available at your local genealogical Society. This gives you a start on collecting information and knowing what else you need to find on that ancestor. The <u>Family Group Sheet allows</u> you to fill out who was in that family and asks for information on their birth dates, marriage and death dates as well as spouse's name. This allows you to keep track of the siblings of an ancestor. A <u>Research Log</u> is helpful in keeping track of what documents and books you have already researched. It is important to note what information you were looking for in that source and if you found it. Negative information is important so you don't go back and redo earlier work. There are also forms to help extract information from Probate Records, Census Records and other documents.

If you don't have the forms, write to us and we can let you know what we have available and the cost. Remember a self-addressed-stamped envelope will help insure a reply.

## COURT RECORDS (Cont. p 80)

It may also contain name changes which would be very important to the researcher.

Adoption records may or may not be available to the genealogy researcher. If accessed, these records may contain the name of the birth mother and father or they may only contain the name of the individual. Recent adoption records will probably be sealed and can only be accessed by court order.

Name change records would be very valuable if you knew where to look for them. If an ancestor disappeared from some local and he may have been having problems, you might check the file for name changes to see if that's where he disappeared.

Criminal records will probably be the hardest to research for genealogical information. However, if you get into these files, you might find why Great-uncle Bill ended up in the penitentiary.

Court records may hold the key to your success as a researcher but they are harder to access and require time and perseverance to extract the information available. Good luck in this area of your research.

birthplace of the parents for each person listed.

The 1890 Census was a disaster in that most of the records were burned in a fire in 1921. Some records did survive but for the most part this Census was lost.

The 1900 Census was expanded to include the month and year of birth for each member of the family as well as the number of years each married couple had been married. It also added the number of children the wife had and how many of them were still living at the time of the enumeration. This was a great help in determining the size of families.

In the 1910 Census, the month and year of birth was dropped, but it did report for each couple if it was the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or whatever marriage for this couple. The 1920 Census dropped the number of years married and the number of children born to the wife.

The 1930 Census, released in 2002, contained much the same information as the previous three censuses. The problem with this census is the lack of indexing. The Works Progress Administration completed indexing only 10 of the States and they finished partial indexes for 2 other States. Those having completed indexes include: AL, AR, FL, LA, MS, NC, SC, TN and VA. Partial indexing occurred for KY and WV. The lack of indexes make these records hard to research as you need to know more precisely where the individual lived and the Enumeration District where he was counted. These census records are available on CD ROM from Heritage Quest and can be read on a home computer. Microfilm is also available but you need a reader to work with this information.

Census records were taken on a specific date for each enumeration. The first four census were supposed to have been taken on specific days during the first week in August. From 1830 to 1900 the official Census Date was June 1<sup>st</sup>. The 1910 Census was listed as being taken on April 15<sup>th</sup>, while the 1920 Census was moved to January 1<sup>st</sup>. The 1930 Census was listed as being taken on April 1<sup>st</sup>. Of interest was that the date of the 1930 Alaska Census was October 1, 1929 because of anticipated severe weather.

Census records are relatively easy to find. Many libraries will have microfilm copies of records for the local area. State Archives will also have copies of these records and Historical and Genealogical Societies many also have copies. The nearest Family History Center of the LDS Church can also make these available to you. The 1880 Census and National Index is available on CD ROM from the Family History Center. This information is contained on 56 CD's which include a nationwide index, regional data discs and the program, *Resource File Viewer*, which can be installed on your PC. This is an excellent resource to find that long lost relative who disappeared after the Civil War and you have not been able to locate him.

Robert Withrow born 10 May 1723 and Elizabeth Evans born 25 Jun 1730 were William S.'s parents, both born in Ulster, Ireland. They married on 13 May 1747 in Wilmington, DE. Their children are believed to be Agnes, James, John, William S., Robert Samuel, Susanna and Sarah.

Robert's parents were Robert Withrow, born 24 Aug 1693 Ulster, Ireland. He married a Jennet/Janet on 14 May 1714. Jennet was bom 1 Feb 1686/87 in Ulster. He is believed to the the original immigrant arriving at Wilmington, DE and by 1738 was in Chester, PA. His known family consisted of William, John, James, Robert and Jane.

nealogical Societies. These indexes are an excellent research tool but care must be taken to check the original records to be sure that errors haven't been introduced.

An area to consider when searching census records is to look at where the county lines were drawn for that period. In the 1800's, county lines frequently shifted because of population changes. A relative might be found in one county and 10 years later he's in another. The ancestor did not move, the county line did.

Searching census records in a city can be difficult if you do not know the Enumeration District. One aid to this search is to look for the street names and house numbers, which are found in the left hand column of the sheet. A city map or directory may help in narrowing down the search to a given area of the city. Enumeration Districts were limited in size to about 4000 persons, which was about what a single enumerator could reach. The Districts were relatively small and were not the same in succeeding censuses.

Once you find an ancestor, it is important that you look at the names of the people in that neighborhood. Many times you will find relatives of the individual or you may find die spouse and their family. It's easier to record the information when you have the records before you than it is to go back and find the record again. You may also find people were not listed in the index but were living in the household as a servant or hired hand.

When searching census records, it is best to start with the most recent census available and then work back in a systematic manner. Using this approach, you may find grandparents or older siblings who were living in the household but subsequently passed on. Also be sure that you record the source of each record that you search. Record the reel if it is a microfilm or book, Enumeration District, sheet and line or page number. Don't let the excitement of a "find" make you forget where you got it. It's difficult to go back to the original record after several months when you didn't record the document where you found it.

Census records should be excellent sources of information, but there are no guarantees that all the information is accurate. A family member, a relative or possibly a neighbor, may have given the enumerator erroneous information. The census-taker may have stopped at the foot of a "hollow" and asked a local if anyone lived "back there". He may also have gotten his information from a neighbor because no one was home and the census-taker didn't plan to travel back that way. Ages are sometime suspect on a census for various reasons. Sometimes it could be in the timing of the enumeration. Others could be that an individual need a couple of extra years for that pension or may they wanted to shave a couple of years so the neighbor didn't think they were that old. Maybe they forgot. If you find an individual on two or three censuses, you can probably make an educated guess as to the year.

There are some states that took a census of the population. This was usually in the odd year between two of the Federal Census. These are also excellent sources of information. You may have to check with your local library or archives to see if a state census is available.

Federal law requires that census records remain confidential for a period of seventy-two years. The 1930 Census came available in 2002 and it will be 2012 before the 1940 Census will be released. Information on an individual can only be released to that person or to his or her authorized representative or legal beneficiary on proof of death. Form BC-600 should be used for this request and it can be obtained from the Bureau of Census, PO Box 1545, Jeffersonville, IN 47131.

## YOUR ROOTS ON-LINE

The easiest way to do your family research is from the comfort of your own home and on-line. It saves having to pack up those books and papers in a tote bag and traveling to the nearest public or genealogical library

Probably the best site for research is Ancestry.com, Tfiis is not a free site and you must obtain a membership to use it. Trial memberships are available but they are limited in what you can get and they only last for 30 days. The annual U.S. Deluxe membership jsost \$155.40,' which is \$12.95 a month. If you elect to pay this membership on a monthly basis, the charge is \$29.95. A World membership is \$347.40 for a year, which amounts to \$28.95 per month. The monthly membership fee for this category is \$39.95. Ancestry.com has the following recordsiU'.S. Census, birth, marriage, death, immigration and military records, court, land and probate records. You can view the original hand written U.S. Census records to find such details as name, age, birth place, residence, home value, occupation, read or write, immigration date and other information. The records are indexed so that a search is fairly simple. The problem is digging your ancestor out of the number of hits that you get for each search.

Another site is Familysearch org, which is sponsored by the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. This site now has select U.S., British and Canadian Census Records, as well as U.S. Social Security Death Index and some birth, marriage and death records. The cost of this site is free. You can also review the thousands of rolls of film that are available from the L.D.S. Church and order them for your use through a local Family History Center.

MyHeritage Research is available through MyHeritage.com'affd'allows researchers to type in an ancestor's name and to search more than Four Hundred databases around the world. The initial search is free, but you may be requi<u>red</u> to pay a fee to access some of the individual databases^

Legacy.com is another interesting site. They have indexed" nearly five million recent and archived obituaries from daily newspapers for the past six years. This may not help for and in-depth ancestor search but it might pick up later family members that have died and you didn't pick it up. The initial search is free but subsequent searches in newspaper archives may require a fee.

The Internet is fast becoming the best tool for genealogical research. The many genealogical sites that can be found will reveal a wealth on information. Much of this information was extracted and published by individual members of genealogical societies, who are working to preserve the records. I urge you to support your local genealogical society so that this information will continue to be collected and be available.
